Key Updates

Election: I am incredibly grateful to Josh Hauble, our Election Clerk, and all the Election Judges for managing a smooth voting process, and to our citizens for the wonderful voter turnout. Congratulations to Councilmembers Ruth Hovey and Bill McNaughton on their re-election, and a warm welcome to Councilmember-elect Nina Zelazny! I'd also like to thank Councilmember Jenna Jones for her service, and I am honored to be re-elected as your mayor.

Public Works: As we honor the memory of our dear friend, Chris Klar, we are thoughtfully working through a transition plan for his role as Public Works Superintendent. Several community members have stepped in to assist in the short-term as we develop a long-term plan. We will discuss this further in our December Council Meeting.

EPA Federal Grant: I'm thrilled to share that we've submitted the required paperwork to receive \$680,000 from the EPA Federal Grant for our street/water/sewer capital project. This money will have a significant positive impact on our city.

Chris Klar Memorial: Thank you to everyone who has donated to Chris's memorial fund. For those who would still like to contribute, donations are being accepted. We'll be planting a beautiful sugar maple at the city entrance to honor Chris and Alan, with additional plans for a commemorative feature in Jevne Park near the pavilion.

This past month has reminded us all of the importance of community—supporting each other as we honor the memory of Chris Klar and carry forward with our city's operations. Thank you, everyone, for your commitment and care.

Fundraiser for Second Harvest Heartland

- ✓ For the **Six Time**, the City of Medicine Lake Community Club has organized a fundraiser to assist Second Harvest Heartland to provide food for the hungry in our communities.
- ✓ **“Match the Match”**. This year several residents have agreed to match the first \$12,500 raised to bring our community total to \$25,000. Then this \$25,000 total will be matched by a generous corporate donor so Second Harvest receives \$50,000. So, for **every \$1 you donate, \$4 will go to Second Harvest!**
- ✓ Second Harvest sources and distributes food to nearly 1000 food shelves, soup kitchens, shelters, senior centers and others programs in Minnesota.
- ✓ The need for food shelves keeps rising. Food, housing and energy costs are more than 30% higher than before the pandemic.
- ✓ In 2023 Second Harvest saw 7.5 million visits to food shelves. That’s up from another record of 5.5 million the year before.
- ✓ Second Harvest turns a \$1 donation into 3 meals. A \$10 donation will feed a person for 10 days. A \$100 donation feeds a family of 4 for a month.
- ✓ Any size donation is appreciated. If you are able, please consider a larger gift of \$100, \$250, \$500 or more. Please donate now?

Last year we raised \$18,500. Our goal this year (with local match) is \$25,000.

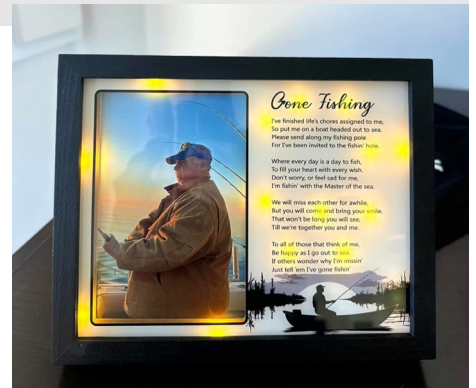
