ORDINANCE NO. 147

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SMOKING IN CITY PARKS AND CITY PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF MEDICINE LAKE

The City Council of the City of Medicine Lake, Minnesota, does ordain:

Section 1: Purpose

It is the purpose of this ordinance to regulate smoking and Electronic Delivery Devices within the City of Medicine Lake to protect the general health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Medicine Lake.

Section 2: Application

This Ordinance applies to city owned property and public parks.

Application. This Section applies to public parks described as park land, lake, stream, pond, trail, nature area, open space or recreation center and amenities within. It should also mean any other property owned, leased, used or controlled, wholly or partly by the City for parks and recreation use.

Section 3: Definitions

Definitions. The following words, terms and phrases, as used herein, shall have the following meanings:

ELECTRONIC DELIVERY DEVICE: Any product containing or delivering nicotine, lobelia or any other substance, whether natural or synthetic, intended for human consumption through the inhalation of aerosol or vapor from the product. Electronic delivery device includes, but is not limited to, devices manufactured, marketed or sold as e-cigarettes, e-cigars, e-pipes, vape pens, mods, tank systems, or under any other product name or descriptor.

SMOKING: Inhaling, exhaling, burning or carrying any lighted or heated cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other lighted or heated product containing, made or derived from nicotine, cannabis, hemp, or other plant or substance, whether natural or synthetic, that is intended for inhalation. Smoking will also include using an electronic delivery device.

Section 4: Prohibited Acts, Regulations

Smoking is prohibited in all City Parks, in all public parking lots that are adjacent to City Parks, and inside all motor vehicles located in any City Park or adjacent public parking lot.

Section 5: Effective Date

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
