

Water Installation Information:

Installation of water requires payment of fees by the homeowner and three permits.

Homeowner Fees:

After finding a contractor to install your water, contact the Plymouth Building Inspections Department at 763-509-5430 and let them know you want to hook up to city water. This initiates an email to you from Plymouth with instructions and a Sewer and

Water Hook up Worksheet which lists the City Water Connection Fees paid by the homeowner:

- WREC fee: approximately \$1500
- Water Area fee: approximately \$2,900
- Total Fees Paid: approximately \$4400

You deliver The Sewer and Water Hook Up Worksheet and your check for the total fees (made payable to the City of Medicine Lake) directly to Plymouth City Hall, Permit and Inspections Division, 3400 Plymouth Blvd. Plymouth, MN 55447, during regular business hours.

Permits:

There are three required permits for water installation.

1. Right of Way Permit obtained from the City of Medicine Lake:

The City of Medicine Lake requires a Right of Way Permit for the water connections that involve excavation or obstruction of the right of way. 2. Sewer and Water Permit obtained from Plymouth.
