RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AN AMENDED JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT FOR THE UTILIZATION BY THE CITY OF MEDICINE LAKE OF CITY OF PLYMOUTH RENTAL INSPECTIONS PERSONNEL

WHEREAS, the Plymouth City Council adopted Resolution 2012-135 on April 24, 2012 approving a Joint Powers Agreement between the City of Plymouth and the City of Medicine Lake for the City of Plymouth to provide rental licensing inspection services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plymouth has not increased its fee schedule for rental inspections for the City of Medicine Lake since 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plymouth has determined that an amended fee structure is appropriate to cover inflationary rental inspections costs; and

WHEREAS, the Plymouth City Code currently references the 2012 International Property Maintenance Code; and

WHEREAS, state law expressly allows the execution of joint powers agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDICINE LAKE, MINNESOTA that the amended Joint Powers Agreement is approved and authorizes the Mayor, City Clerk or his/her designee to execute such agreement


