

VILLAGE OF FRIENDSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 1997-46

SYNOPSIS:

WHEREAS, the citizens of the village are encouraged to utilize the natural resources of the village including placement of ice fishing shanties on Friendship Lake during permissible winter months; and

WHEREAS, it is adverse to the health and safety of citizens in the community that ice fishing shanties be placed on village property for extended periods of time; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to control the placement of ice fishing shanties on the areas used for approach to Friendship Lake;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Friendship Board of Trustees that:

1. No ice fishing shanty shall be allowed to remain on that village property next to and adjacent to Friendship Lake, commonly known as the Friendship Lake Beach parking lot and lake access ramp, between March 5 and December 15 of the year.
2. No ice fishing shanty shall be placed on said village property for a period longer than one week between December 15 and March 5 of the subsequent calendar year.
3. Any person owning, placing or allowing to remain an ice fishing shanty on village property other than above provided shall be liable for reasonable costs of removal and storage of said ice fishing shanty.
4. If the Village or its agent removes any ice fishing shanty from its property, the Village will notify the owner as identified on said shanty and if said owner does not claim his or her ice fishing shanty before the expiration of ten (10) days after notice given to the owner, said Village may destroy or sell said ice fishing shanty and the Village and its agents shall be exempt from all liability to the owner for such seizure and destruction or sale.

Adopted by a vote of 7 in favor, 0 against, and 0 absent, this 2ND day of September, 1997.
