
Q5 Do you rent or own your current primary residence?



Q12 If employed and working at least 1 day per week OUTSIDE YOUR HOME, where do you work?










Q23 What gender do you identify with?


Q24 Which race/ethnicity do you identify with? (choose all that apply)



Q25 How many people live in your home, including yourself?




