Elder Abuse - 608-339-4251 ext. 1

Physical, material, financial, mental abuse, or self-neglect can be reported and appropriate referrals and/or follow-up will be conducted in a confidential manner. *Call the Adult Protective Services Helpline at (608) 261-9933 to report suspected abuse or neglect of adults who are age 60 and older.*

Medical rides - Reservations are requested at least 2 business days in advance and rides are first come first serve, dependent upon availability of drivers. Wheelchair accessible vans are available. A co-pay is required.

The Find Your Own Driver Program (FYOD) which allows the participant to select their own driver for transportation to medical appointments. The participant is reimbursed for mileage and in turn, reimburses their driver. Please call our office for complete eligibility qualifications.

Nutrition Programs– 608-339-4251 ext. 3

Dinning Site Meals Nutritious meals are provided for individuals 60 years or older. There are no income guidelines. Meals are available on a donation basis with a suggested donation of \$4.00. No one will be denied a meal due to their inability to contribute.

Home Delivered Meals-are provided to individuals age 60 or older who are homebound and unable to prepare adequate meals on their own. Hot meal delivery is Monday through Thursday with frozen meals available Friday, Saturday, and Sundays. Please call our office for complete eligibility qualifications.

Assist individuals over the age of 60 years old. Assists with Medicare, Medicare Supplements, Social Security Income (SSI), Medical Assistance, Consumer Problems, Housing Problems, Partner Care and Disability Claims.

Resources Specialists provide resourced to elderly and disabled to promote independence with the goal of keeping people in their homes as long as possible. If a person can not stay in their home then assistance for Long Term Care Programs is provided. Disability Benefits Specialist - Assist individuals under the age of 60 years old with obtaining disability benefits.
