OPERATOR (BARTENDER) LICENSE INFORMATION

- Fee: \$5.00
- Operator's Licenses for the Town of Amberg are issued for 1 year, all expiring on June 30th.
- You must be at least 18 years of age or older to obtain an operator's license.
- To apply for a new Operator's License one of the following must be provided along with your completed, signed application form:
 - Proof of Registration for the Responsible Beverage Servers Course.
 - Certificate of Completion from the Responsible Beverage Servers Course (dated within the past year.)
 - A current Operator's license from another municipality in the State of Wisconsin.
- License fees are non-refundable and are to be paid at the time of filing the application form.
- If an Operator's License is needed immediately, a temporary Provisional License may be applied for. Only one Provisional License per person per year will be issued. Provisional Licenses are valid for 60 days after issuance. Provisional Licenses will only be issued to an applicant enrolled in and pending completion of an authorized Responsible Beverage Server Course and who has not be denied an Operator's License or who has not had their license revoked or suspended within the past twelve (12) months.

- **Violation of any of the terms or provisions of State or Local laws relating to operator's license by any person holding such operator's license shall be cause for revocation of the license.**
