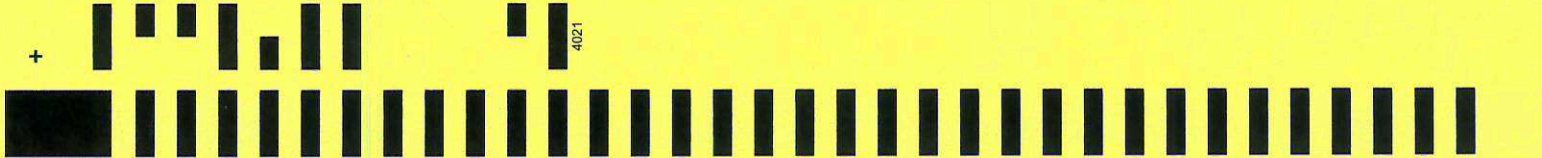
General Instructions:
