#### Notes from the Clerk-Treasurer's Office

If you require a seasonal water/sewer shut-off, there is a form available at City Hall (or on the City website) that must be completed prior to shut-off. Your service will then be shut off on the requested date and you will not accumulate water or sewer charges until you request the service be restored. There is a \$20 reconnect fee that will be charged at that time. Please note that you will continue to be charged for garbage and recycling.

We have a lot of information at City Hall, including senior resources, available programs to conserve water and reduce utility costs, area attractions, etc. Feel free to stop by and pick up one of the many brochures we have!

#### Notes from the Police Department

If you call the police department's regular number and we do not answer, Morrison County dispatch will pick up the phone after the fourth ring and will contact us by radio to respond to your call. If an officer is not on duty, a sheriff's deputy will be able to help you.

The City of Motley now has a drop box to dispose of unwanted prescriptions located in the entryway at City Hall. Medication must be kept in their original container and personal information should be removed or covered up with black marker. Needles/sharps are not accepted. Properly disposing of medication can prevent contamination of our lakes and rivers and help prevent drug abuse.



#### **Notes from the Fire Department**

**FIREFIGHTERS WANTED!** The Motley Fire Department is accepting applications for volunteer firefighters. Applicants must be a minimum of 18 years of age, have a valid Minnesota driver's license, live within an acceptable response time area and be able to pass a physical examination. Firefighters receive \$9.00 for each call/meeting/training attended. Applicants will be reviewed on a rolling basis. Applications are available at City Hall and on the city website.
