

Project Overview

- Proposal to expand natural gas service to Fairfield, UT
- Utilize Utah HB422 program
- Prior communities through HB422: Eureka, Portage, Genola, Green River, Goshen, Elberta
- Who pays?
 - Company pays for pipelines, service lines, meters
 - Customers pay for downstream of meter

Start construction	April 2026
Complete construction	Sept 2026



New Customer Service Process

Steps:

- After state of Utah project approval, Enbridge will begin signing up customers.
- Gas mains installed by Sept 2026
- Service line construction from July 2026 to Sept 2028
- Customer to complete any required appliance or fuel line conversions
- Get city or county to issue permit
- Enbridge to hook up gas meter and begin service

Important Dates


- Residents have 2 years (approx. Sept 2028) to sign up for a service line
 - Customers will be responsible for service line cost after that date
- New customers have 2 years after getting their service line to get their meter installed
 - · Must have one gas appliance to get a meter installed



Costs: Natural Gas vs Propane

- Propane cost: \$2.28/gal
 - 1 gal propane = .0955 dth/gal
 - Propane cost per dth = \$23.87 per dth
- Cost of natural gas per dth = \$8.33 per dth
 - Enbridge monthly basic service fee = \$6.75
- Average annual gas consumption per home in Utah = 68.1 dth
 - Annual cost for natural gas = \$650 (includes monthly service fee)
 - Annual cost for propane = \$1,623
- Cost ratio propane/natural gas = 2.5










Natural Gas Facts

- Composition
 - Mostly methane, some ethane, propane
- Heat Content: ~1040 btu per cubic foot
- Specific gravity: 0.6 (lighter than air)
- Required air/fuel ratio for ignition: 5% to 15%
- Odorant (mercaptan) added for safety
