Like so many other area Townships, due to the levy limits for several years, the Town of Cold Spring is needing to borrow money to fix a few township roads that are severely deteriorated. Early estimates of the work to be done are approximately \$750,000. The Town Board would like your input regarding how quickly to repay the loan (ie. What your tax bill increase would be). Here are some examples:

Assessed value of \$225,900 paid approx. \$347.61 in township taxes last year-(\$1.66 per thousand mil rate) Same assessed value of \$225,900 would pay \$526.82 in township taxes paying \$50,000/yr in debt service (\$2.33 per thousand mil rate)

Same assessed value of \$225,900 would pay \$602.92 in township taxes paying \$75,000/yr in debt service (\$2.66 per thousand mil rate)

Same assessed value of \$225,900 would pay \$679.03 in township taxes paying \$100,000/yr in debt service (\$3.01 per thousand mil rate)

Roads needing work are Cold Spring Road, Howard Road and Pechous Lane.

This will be on the agenda to be discussed monthly (meetings begin at 7 p.m. and are usually the second Thursday of each month), please consider attending an upcoming meeting. The board is looking to borrow for 2022 projects.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Town Board Meetings – Meetings are generally held the second Thursday of each month at 7PM at the Town Hall. Agenda and notices are posted at the Town Hall, Travelers Park and The Real MacCoy's as well as published in the Legal Section of the Daily Jefferson County Union.

Fire & Ambulance – Whitewater Fire Dept, Inc provides Fire and Ambulance services. There is a fire call charge of at least \$1000 per call, even for a false alarm or an unreported controlled burn, plus \$250/HR for time exceeding 2 hours. Ambulance call charges are billed based on equipment used and mileage. Payments for these services are due upon receipt.

To Report a Controlled Fire/Burn - If you're planning a controlled burn or pit fire, call both the Whitewater Fire Dept @ 262-473-0555 and the Jefferson County Sheriff Dept @ 920-674-7310.

Road Maintenance – The Town of Cold Spring provides snowplowing, sanding, mowing and maintenance for all town roads. Please respect the road right-of-way by not using it for dumping of refuse, leaves, branches, or trash. When plowing your driveway, **DO NOT PUSH THE SNOW ACROSS THE ROAD INTO THE TOWN RIGHT-OF-WAY.**

Elections – All elections are held at the Town Hall from 7 am – 8 pm. Voter registration is required and can be done on the day of the election at the polls. Contact the Clerk at 262-473-6228 or go to **wisvote.gov** to register to vote or to request an absentee ballot.

Refuse/Recyclable Collection – Collections schedules are included with your tax bill. A "once a month" bulk pickup per address is available at no cost by contacting John's Disposal 262-473-4700. Trash/Recycling Fees are a special assessment on your tax bill.

Resolution #1-2019 and Ordinance 2019-1 were adopted and passed at the November 19, 2019 Board Meeting. Resolution 2019-R1 rescinded resolution 2014-R1 and updated the Town's Building Permit Fees. Ordinance 2019-1 created a Building and Mechanical Code for the Town of Cold Spring and Repealed Town Ordinance 2000-4.
