MILITARY HOMETOWN HERO BANNER MEMORIAL PROGRAM POLICY AND GUIDELINES

About the Program

The City of Chesnee Military Hometown Hero Banner Memorial Program provides the opportunity for the community to recognize and honor former city residents who have served in the United States Armed Forces. The Military Hometown Hero banner will be displayed from designated City locations during specific times of the year. To allow for a coordinated and consistent program, the City has established the following policy and guidelines for the Military Hometown Hero Banner Memorial Program.

Guidelines

Eligibility

- This is a memorial program to honor retired, or honorably discharged members of the five United States Armed Forces service branches (Army, Marines, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, and Space Force). Applications will only be approved for nominees that have passed on.
- A former Chesnee resident

Proof of eligibility will be required before an application is considered complete.

- Proof of residency of the nominee.
- Verification of active-duty dates (e.g. copy of military orders or military ID)
- Honorable discharge or retirement papers (e.g. DD214, WD AGO, NAVPERS)
- High-resolution digital image (minimum 300 dpi) in jpeg format or 5x7 photograph of honoree in official uniform (with no objects). PHOTO WILL NOT BE RETURNED, PLEASE ONLY SEND A COPY OF THE PHOTO

Application

 A written application for placement of a Hero banner must be completed using the City of Chesnee Hometown Hero Banner Memorial Program Application form

Banner Locations

- The City has designated 56 locations on Cherokee Street and Alabama Avenue
- Available space is determined by the City of Chesnee among qualified applicants. All banner locations shall be determined solely by the City of Chesnee.



Display Period

- The banners will be displayed from mid-January through November of each year.
- Displayed periods will be determined on the number of applications received.
- Retired banners will be offered to applicants, all unclaimed banners will become property of the City of Chesnee.
- In addition to the banners, the City will also display the banner images on the City's website for year-round display.

Banner Style and Display

The City of Chesnee has determined the following specifications for the banners. The specifications and design of the banners are at the sole discretion of the City and can be modified at any time.

- Double sided, vinyl, weatherproof
- 30" x 60"

Procedures

The Chesnee Hometown Hero Banner Memorial Application may be obtained from one of the following:

- The City of Chesnee website at cityofchesnee.org
- Email the Events Coordinator, Shellie Main, smain@cityofchesnee.org
- Or picking up an application for Chesnee City Hall

Applications are accepted on a year-round basis. A Waiting list shall be established based on the date a complete application is received in the City office. In order for an application to be considered all supporting documentation must be received and verified by the City of Chesnee.

- Applicants will be notified by City staff once an installation date has been determined.
- At the end of the banner display period, City staff will contact the applicant to offer them the banner.

Waiver and Limitations

The City of Chesnee is not responsible for replacing banners that are stolen, damaged, or destroyed due to age, vandalism, or any acts of nature, including high winds. Any loss or damage to an installed banner will be handled at the discretion of the City. The City reserves the right to not install a banner if the above requirements have not been met.
