PARADE RULES:

- 1. Every entry must pre-register by completing the parade application form.
- 2. The City of Chesnee requests a donation be made to KOPS KIDS as an entry fee, donations should be made at the time of application being submitted.
- 3. NO <u>THROWING</u> OF ANY CANDY. Failure to comply will result in IMMEDIATE removal and suspension from future participation. Candy, flyers, and handouts may be <u>handed</u> to bystanders.
- 4. All entries (motorized and ridden) must remain in the center of parade route.
- 5.All motorized vehicles must be operated by a licensed driver and general liability and/or auto insurance will be maintained.
- 6. CITY WILL PROVIDE SANTA NO OTHER SANTA IS ALLOWED IN PARADE
- 7. Floats transporting children more than thirty (30") inches from the ground will have side rails. Rails should measure a minimum of three feet from the floor of the unit.
- 8. To ensure the safety of riders, all children must be unloaded from floats/open units at the end of the parade route.
- 9. Parents, or other responsible adults (18 yrs. or older), must be at the end of the parade route to pick up their children.
- 10.The ratio of adult chaperones to children will be no less than 1:10 for ages 6 to 12 or 1:5 for preschoolers.
