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BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE SPECIAL OPERATIONS UNIT

MISSION STATEMENT

Our mission is to be prepared and ready to respond, assess and safely and effectively rescue person in danger. The scope of our responsibility included specialized technical rescue situations such as confined space, high and low angle rescue, building collapse rescue, trench rescue and rescues that are not within the capabilities of any other Neptune-based agency providing service to services to Neptune Township at this time. Other services provided include medical monitoring for Haz Mat, rescue responses and mutual aid.

MEMBERSHIP OVERVIEW

The Neptune Special Operations Team is comprised of the emergency services groups in Neptune Township. The team accepts members under the following guidelines.

- Must be dedicated, motivated, team player and have a positive attitude.
- Must be an active member in good standings with affiliate agency and approved by agency supervisor. Affiliate agencies include Neptune Township and Ocean Grove emergency services.
- Candidates who reside in close proximity to Neptune Township may be considered.
- Must have a minimum of three (3) years as an emergency responder.
- Training in technical rescue skills preferred: Confined Space Awareness and Operations, Building Collapse, Rope Rescue, Trench Rescue, etc.

TEAM STRUCTURE

- Command Staff
 - Manages Team, Command and Control, etc.
 - Maintain equipment, plans, reviews compliance, oversees drills, etc.
- Team member
 - Maintains an active role on team.
 - Displays a positive attitude on all levels in support of team.
 - Attends and participates in all training drills.
 - Is able to respond to emergencies and function under the established chain-of-command and incident command structure.
 - Works under “team” concept and can carry-out assignments and tasks in a competent and effective manner.

RESPONSE AND TRAINING

- Members are expected to maintain an active response percentage.
- Members are expected to attend and participate at training drills and exercises. The team trains 1-2 times per month and occasionally on a Saturday and/or Sunday morning.
