THE TOWN OF RUTLAND HAS RECENTLY ADDED A NEW CONTAINER FOR THE COLLECTION OF ELECTRONICS. ATTACHED PLEASE SEE THE FOLLOWING LIST OF ITEMS THAT CAN BE ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING.

Computer Equipment: Computer Towers, Tablets, Laptops, Modems and Routers, Docking Station, Desktop Copiers, Fax Machines, Desktop Printers, Scanners, Keyboards, Web Cams, Speakers, Hard Drives, Circuit Boards.

Entertainment: VCR's/DVD Players, Blu Ray Players, DVR/TIVO, Cell Phones and Chargers, Cameras, MP3 players, Headphones, Turntables, eReaders, Sound Machine, Game Systems, Radio, Stereo, Surround Sound Systems, Speakers, Subwoofers, Satellite Dishes

Exercise Equipment: Elliptical, Stationary Bike, Treadmill, Weight Bench

Household Electronics: Vacuum, Roomba, Carpet Cleaner, Smart Speakers (Alexa, Home, Nest,

Portal), Scale, Security Systems/Doorbells, String Lights/Christmas Lights

Small Kitchen Appliances: Air Fryer, Blender, Coffee maker, Crock Pot, Juicer, Mixer, Toaster, Griddle, etc.

Lawn Tools: Leaf Blower, Trimmer, Edger, Power Washer, Mower/Snow Blower.

Power Tools: Drill Saw, Compressor, Sander, etc.

Power Cords and Strips

- ** Make sure all gas and oil and other fluids are drained and rubber tires removed.
- ** Batteries and items that batteries cannot be removed need to be placed in a separate barrel to prevent fires.

ALSO ATTACHED IS A LIST OF ITEMS THAT ARE PROHIBITED FROM COLLECTION. THESE ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED:

Hazardous Materials – as defined by the following factors:

- Ignitability Ignitable materials can create fires under certain conditions, and are spontaneously combustible. Examples include magnesium turnings.
- Corrosive Corrosive materials are acids or bases that are capable of corroding metal containers. Battery acid and liquid drain cleaner are examples.
- Reactivity Reactive Materials can cause explosions, toxic fumes, gases, or vapors when heated, compressed, or mixed with water. Examples include explosives, gasoline fumes.
- Toxicity toxic materials are harmful or fatal when ingested or absorbed (e.g. insecticides, mercury, etc.).
- Mercury-Containing Equipment: Thermostats or thermometers; Mercury Switches; Light Bulbs/tubes co-mingled with other non-light bulb/tube items.

Other Materials - when in doubt, ask facility attendant.

- Radioactivity Materials marked by radioactive decals or with unacceptable radioactive levels.
- Biomedical Materials described, marked, or otherwise classified as Biological, Medical or Infectious Material.

- Dusts & Powders no dusts or powders are accepted without approval.
- Any Closed Gas Cylinder valve must be completely open/removed, or a hole punched in the side of the cylinder to prove it is completely empty.
- Live Ammunition
- PCB Containing Materials
- Leaking / Actively Combusting Batteries
- Grave Markers or Beer Kegs or any sort, without proof of ownership
