2020 Tax Levy

The 2020 Tax Levy was approved on November 14, 2019 by the Town Residents at the annual Town Budget meeting which is held for that purpose. The 2020 tax levy amount is \$743,874 on an overall Town of Rutland assessed value of \$249,946,100. This computes to a Mill Rate of \$2.976 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

This means that a property owner with \$300,000 of assessed value will pay \$892.80 of taxes to the Town. By way of comparison, the 2019 tax levy Mill Rate was \$2.969 and a property owner with \$300,000 of assessed value paid \$890.70 of taxes to the Town.

2020 Budget

The Town Board approved the year 2020 budget on November 14, 2019. The budget includes a record \$595,000 of spending for road repair, road rebuilding, chip sealing and paving. This level of spending will allow the Town to address several key areas in one year.

Long term planning is also included in the 2020 budget. For example, reserve accounts are funded, election systems are being upgraded and new road crew and fire protection equipment is being acquired.

The Town of Rutland continues to be a partner in the three fire and EMS districts that serve our residents (Brooklyn, Oregon and Stoughton) and the Town continues to be a partner in the operations of the Oregon Senior Center.

If you have thoughts, ideas, comments or questions about future budgets, please contact any Town Board Member. The 2021 and 2022 Budgets will include more road repairs and an eventual decision as to the upgrade or replacement for the Town Hall.
