# **ADVERTISEMENT FOR SEALCOATING (CHIP SEALING) BIDS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town of Rutland is seeking bids for 2025 sealcoating (chip sealing) of several Town roads as identified below.

Bids should be submitted to Town Clerk Dawn George at 4177 Old Stage Rd., Brooklyn, WI 53521 by 11:00 a.m. on March 3, 2025 Clerk's email – <u>clerk@town.rutland.wi.us</u> for questions.

Bids will be publicly opened on March 3, 2025 at 11:00 a.m at the Town Hall located at 785 Center Rd. It is anticipated that the Bids will not be awarded until the Board meeting on March 5, 2025. The meeting on March 5th will begin at 6:30 p.m.

#### 1. Project Description

The Town may choose to do only the highest priority roads, depending on cost and budget considerations. Proposals should be submitted as separate projects for each road and if a proposal is submitted for all roads it should be clarified. Bidders may wish to arrange a road inspection trip with the Town's patrolmen to better understand individual project needs and to prepare a more accurate quote. The possible candidates for 2025 seal coating are:

- Center Rd. starting at County road A and ending at Old Stone Rd. using FA3 fractured granite. Please quote price for both gray and black FA3 fractured granite. (6758' – 1.28 mi.)
- North Union Rd starting at Old Stage Rd and ending at Union Dane Rd using FA3 fractured granite. Please quote price for both gray and black FA3 fractured granite. (6124.8' 1.16 miles)

## 2. Specifications:

- Based on use of FA3 fractured granite. Please price both gray and black fractured granite.
- length and width of each road proposed

The Town Board will determine which proposal is deemed to be in the best interests of the Town.

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The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The successful bidder, upon notification, must provide the Town with

- a Certificate of Insurance naming the Town as an additional insured.
- a statement holding the Town harmless from any litigation or claims resulting from the execution of this bid.

## 4. Scheduling

The Town wishes to have this work completed during the 2025 road work season, meaning done prior to September 1. 2025.

Attach a proposed time schedule showing how soon the work can be started after bid acceptance, and how many days or weeks it will take before completion.

#### 5. Payment

Payment to the contractor will be made within 30 days of the completion of the seal coating and an approved inspection by the Town.
