## The New Town Hall Building is finished!

We have been working at cutting some of the 3 to 4 foot tall button weed and tall grasses. Some of the areas are really thick. It is these areas that we will need to remove the debris in order to allow our seeded grasses to make it. If we could get 12 to 15 people to help for a couple of hours, that should take care of most of it. **We will be working in uneven ground with slopes**.

I am not sure which tools will work best. We need to gather the debris into small piles, we will load them on to a gator or small utility tractor loader and haul them away. We need to be mindful and not make tracks on the lawn or compact septic area.

I am thinking that garden rakes or pitch forks may work best to gather the debris into small piles. (Please bring any tools you think might work.) Then lifting and loading the material into the gator or loader. So bring your gloves.

Please park at the old town hall and walk over to the new building.
