

ATTENTION – PLEASE READ

Due to the recent court decision regarding absentee ballot drop boxes, **voters are no longer allowed to return their absentee ballots via the use of drop boxes.**

Options for returning your absentee ballot:

- **Mail it back**

The United States Postal Service recommends mailing your ballot at least one week before the Election Day. Returning a ballot from overseas may take longer.

- **Hand deliver** it to your Municipal Clerk by the end of the work day (4:30 P.M. / M-TH and 1:00 P.M. on Fridays).

You are not allowed to hand deliver another voter's ballot regardless of relationship to the voter. **You may only return your own ballot to the Clerk's office.**

- **Drop your absentee ballot off at your polling place** on Election Day by no later than 8:00 P.M. **Ballots received after 8:00 P.M. on Election Day will not be counted!!!!**
