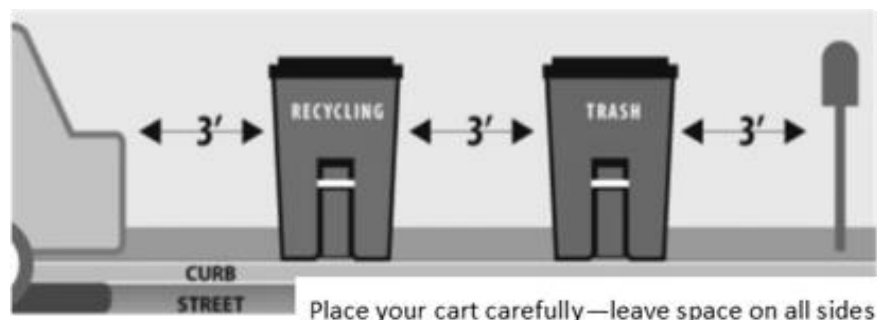
PICK UP FOR REFUSE & RECYCLABLES WILL BE BETWEEN 6:00 A.M. AND 3:00 P.M.
EVERY **MONDAY**: ALL LOCATIONS EXCEPT SOMERSET MEADOWS & RIVER HILLS
EVERY **THURSDAY**: SOMERSET MEADOWS & RIVER HILLS

REFUSE shall be contained within the Solid Waste Cart provided by Olson Sanitation with the cover shut. Available Solid Waste Cart sizes are 32-gal, 64-gal or 96-gal. Changing of solid waste cart sizes is allowed one time per calendar year. Contact the Village offices to request a cart or size change. If more than one cart change is requested in a year a fee of \$25.00 will be charged.

RECYCLABLES are to be placed in the Recycling Cart provided by Olson Sanitation using a Single Sort System in which all recyclables are fully comingled. All recycling must be clean and contained in recycling container with no trash mixed in (See list of what to recycle on back.) Olson Sanitation will provide one 64-gallon Recycling Cart per household. Multi-household owners have the choice of requesting from the Village one recycling cart for each household OR the owner may set up a large, labeled recycling container for their renters to use.

- What to recycle and common contaminants are listed on the back.

CART PLACEMENT: The Carts must have a clear radius of 3 feet to allow for pickup. Carts need to be placed facing the street and positioned all the way to the street.

Your pick-up day will not change unless notified by Olson Sanitation or the Village office

PICK UP CHARGES

Charges are per month and are based on cart size.

Individual Household - Base Fee

32 Gallon Solid Waste Cart	\$16.50
64 Gallon Solid Waste Cart	\$18.50
96 Gallon Solid Waste Cart	\$20.50

Multi-household - Base Fee

Three Unit Dwelling	\$54.50
Four Unit Dwelling	\$72.50

Additional Solid Waste Cart

32 Gallon Solid Waste Cart	\$12.00
64 Gallon Solid Waste Cart	\$14.00
96 Gallon Solid Waste Cart	\$16.00

The Village of Somerset will bill you monthly on your utility bill for the Refuse and Recycling charge.

WHAT TO RECYCLE:

- GLASS bottles & jars
- ALUMINUM, tin & steel cans and lids – rinsed – no scrap metal
- PLASTICS #1-7 bottles, jugs, jars & food tubs- rinsed
- PAPER, flattened cardboard, newspaper & magazines - paper recycling needs to be kept dry

AVOID COMMON CONTAMINANTS:

- NO Plastic Bags/Film - gather the stretchy plastics separately (bring to your local grocery store, Target or Walmart)
- NO Used Paper Products – used napkins, plates, cups, etc. (they can be composted)
- NO wax coated paper or spiral notebooks
- NO light bulbs or aerosol cans
- NO pizza boxes
- NO broken glass or glass dishes

PLACE BESIDE RECYCLING CONTAINERS - Car batteries and flashlight batteries.

NO PICKUP ON FOLLOWING ITEMS

- Tires – NO TIRE PICKUP– Contact Tire Dealer
- Used Motor Oil – NO MOTOR OIL PICKUP – Contact area service stations or check the recycling information on the St. Croix County Website (www.sccwi.gov)

Yard Waste

Grass clippings, leaves and bundled cut-up branches are collected from the beginning of March through the end of November by the Village of Somerset Public Works Department.

1. Place tree branches and brush, bundled in lengths of less than 4 feet and weighing under 50 pounds, curbside.
2. Leaves and grass must be in compostable bags, which are available at most hardware stores. Non-compostable bags are unacceptable and will not be collected.
3. Please call the Public Works Department at 715-247-5555 and provide the address where yard waste pick-up is needed. The yard waste will be picked up within the week.
4. Please keep yard waste separate from Solid Waste and Recycling.
