

Town of Apple River
VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT
April 7th, 2026, Spring Election

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may submit a request to vote an absentee ballot to their municipal clerk. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, and has resided in the ward or municipality where they wish to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered to vote to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

MAKING APPLICATION TO RECEIVE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL

You may make written application to your municipal clerk for an absentee ballot in person, by mail, by fax, by email or at MyVote.wi.gov. Or you may apply in person at the clerk's office during the In-Person Absentee Voting period listed below. Your written request must include your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different from your voting address, your signature, a copy of your photo identification. Contact your clerk with any questions. The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is: 5:00 p.m. Thursday, April 2nd, 2026 (the fifth day before the election).

Voters who are indefinitely confined due to age, illness, infirmity, or disability may not be required to provide photo ID. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot. Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

VOTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IN PERSON

You may also request and vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office during the days and hours specified for casting an absentee ballot in person:

Tuesday, March 24th, 2026 9 am to 1 pm,
Thursday, March 26th, 2026 3 pm to 6 pm,
Tuesday, March 31st, 2026 9 am to 1 pm
at the Apple River Town Hall: 606 US Highway 8, Amery WI 54001,

The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is:

Tuesday, March 24th, 2026

The last day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is:

Thursday, March 31st, 2026

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election.

The municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before Election Day to the proper polling location before the polls close on April 7th, 2026. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
