DMW Patiala gives its best performance amid Covid-19 Despite COVID-19 restrictions hampering the overall production targets, the workers of Diesel Loco Modernisation Works (DMW), Patiala, a Production Unit of Indian Railways,



manufactured 10 DETC (Diesel Electric Traction Car), 06 WAP 9H & 02 WAP 7 Electric Locomotives in April and May (with 30% staff in April and only 20% staff in May). It has achieved a landmark production in rolling out 17 Electric Locomotives/8W-DETCs (02 Nos WAP7, 07 Nos WAG9HC & 08 Nos 8W-DETC) in June 2021. S. N. Dubey, principal chief administrative officer, said that in two years this production unit has shifted its production line from Alco Locomotives to Electric Locomotives. He congratulated the production team of DMW for their dedication towards their work during this pandemic.

Lakshadweep gets medical oxygen generation plants

In COVID-19 pandemic times, uninterrupted oxygen supply by transportation of oxygen cylinders in Lakshadweep was a major area of concern for the UT administration. Under the



leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and efforts of Administrator of Lakshadweep, Praful Patel, the UT has been allotted two medical oxygen generation plants under PMCARES which will be installed in the islands of Kavaratti and Agatti shortly. Three more islands namely Andrott, Aminoni and Minicoy are getting three oxygen plants through CSR funds offered by corporate firms in Gujarat and Maharashtra for which the

works have already started. A skid-mounted PSA Medical Oxygen Generator Plant, which has the capacity of 170 Lpm, was made functional at Minicoy recently. The oxygen generation plant has a flow rate of 10mm³/hr, with a purity of oxygen at 95% + 1%, and is capable of providing oxygen to 50 beds.

CISF takes over security of TFL in Odisha

CISF has taken over the security of Talcher Fertilizers Limited (TFL) in Odisha, with sanctioned strength of more than 120 personnel. The induction ceremony was graced by TFL MD S N Yadav and SEZ-II DIG Mamun-Ur Rashid. IRFC records high revenue, profit for FY21

Indian Railway Finance Corporation Limited (IRFC) recorded a profit growth of 126 per cent on YoY basis for Q4 FY 2020-21 to stand at Rs. 1,482.55 crore versus Rs. 654.63 crore reported in Q4 FY 2019-20. The net profit for FY 2020-21 grew by 38.34 per cent to Rs. 4,416.13 crore as against Rs.3,192.06 crore for the corresponding financial year ended March 31, 2020. Commenting on the financial results, Chairman and Managing Director of IRFC Amitabh Banerjee said, "IRFC continued to show strong growth momentum both in terms of revenue and profit during the financial year driven by the massive investment outlay of Indian Railways which is on an expansion and modernization drive. There will be sustained growth in revenue and profitability going

forward as a major portion of the funding requirement of Indian Railways is to be met through IRFC."
