Uploading

Once you have finished designing, click '**Return** to kaizenprint.com' and you will be directed back to our site. Our clever integration means your print-ready artwork will automatically be uploaded to our site, meaning you don't have to worry about crop marks and bleed.

PS: Your artwork will be stored in your Canva account, and you will be able to download a copy to your device and have on file for future use.

Grant Permission

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After clicking 'Connect to Canva', you will be prompted to grant permissions and login to your Canva account, if you do not yet have an account, you can create one at this step.

Design best practices

Our design best practices help you create professional, eye-catching visuals with ease in Canva.

From balanced layouts and consistent branding to clear typography and highquality imagery, these guidelines ensure your designs are both impactful and effective. Follow these tips to make your Canva creations stand out effortlessly!

Use high quality images

- If you are uploading images or logos to your design on Canva, make sure they are high resolution (300dpi) to minimise the risk of pixelated artwork.
- Keep key content/design elements within the safe zone
- Ensure to place important text, logos or other design elements at least 3mm away from the edge of the design.

Proof your artwork

Before finalising your design, ensure to review it for typos and other common errors such as alignment and legibility.

Page count requirements

Your finished design must match the exact number of pages selected in your product configuration. *For example, if you have selected a 48-page booklet, your Canva design must include all 48 pages in the correct running order, e.g. page 1, page 2, page 3... etc.*

Double sided printing

If you are printing a double-sided product, such as business cards, your design must include both side 1 and side 2. For multi-panel prints such as tri-fold leaflets, you must include designs for all required panels.

Handling multiple designs in one file

You can create multiple versions of your design in the one file. For example, if you are ordering 500 business cards, you can create 2 different designs and print 250 of each. *If you are creating multiple designs within the one file, please specify in the notes section at check out the required quantities for each design. I.e. Design A 250 copies, Design B 250 copies.*

Round stickers

When creating a design for round stickers, the template will be presented as a square. Please ensure to keep all important elements within the centre of the design, as anything in the corners outside of the circular shape will not be visible.
