

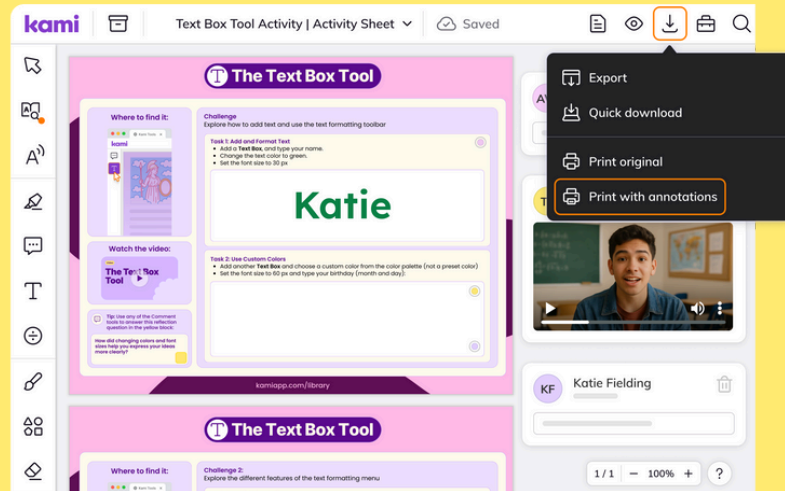


Print with Annotations



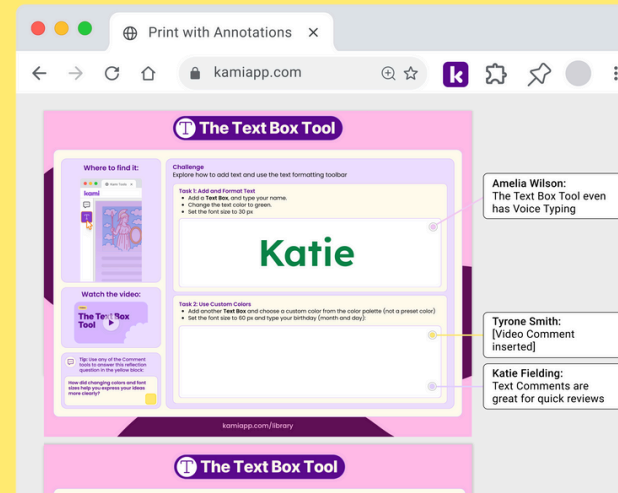
How it Works:

Print (or save as a PDF) a document with annotations, Comments, and feedback visible – ideal for assessment evidence, revision or moderation.



Step 1:

Add annotations to your document
Use **T** Text, **D** Drawings, **V** Voice, or **C** Video Comments, etc., so feedback and thinking are visible on the page.



Step 2:

Export with annotations
Click **E** Export, **P** Print with annotations, preview the output, then print or save as a PDF.

Challenge:

Create a document that shows thinking and feedback when printed:

- Add text using the **T** Text Box Tool
- Add one **V** Voice or **C** Video Comment
- Preview using **P** Print with annotations
