Level 1: Kami Tools to Help You Get Started



Challenge 1: The Markup Tool

Highlight the word or phrase you find most interesting:

The solar system is a group of planets circling the Sun.



Challenge 2: The Comment Tool

1. Add a **Comment** reacting to one idea.
2. Add your **Comment dot** in the light purple circle on the right:

Each planet follows its own invisible path around the Sun.



Challenge 3: The Drawing Tool

About the Understand Menu:

The Understand Menu is your go-to for tools like the **Dictionary**, **Picture Dictionary**, **Translate**, **Explain**, and **Adjust**:



Dictionary:
Look up any word to see what it means.



Picture Dictionary:
Look up any word to see what it means through a picture.



Translate:
Select text to see it in another language.



Explain:
Highlight text or an image, and it will explain it to you.



Summarise:
It makes long text shorter and easier to understand.



Adjust:
Rephrase text at different levels to help you understand it.



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


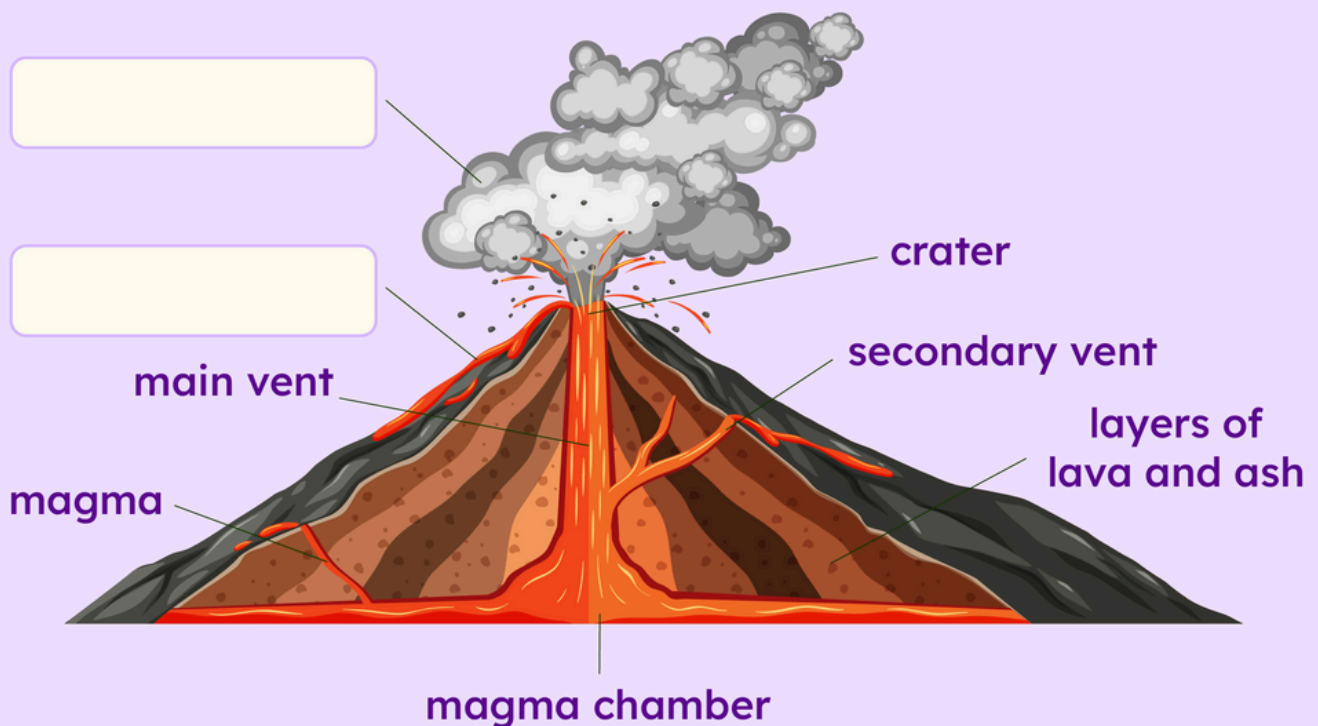
Challenge 5: The Understand Tool (Explain)

1. Use the  **Explain Tool** within the **Understand Tool** to generate an explanation of the sentence below
