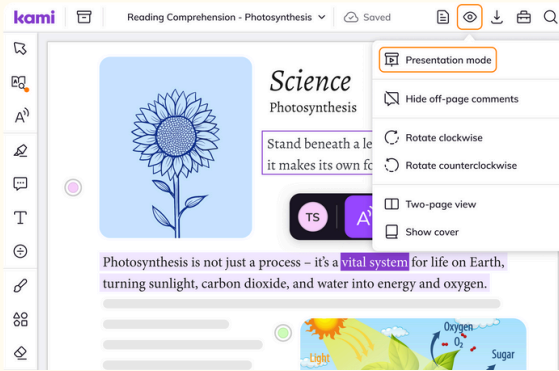
Presentation Mode

What it Does:

Displays your document in a focused, full-screen view while keeping essential tools available.

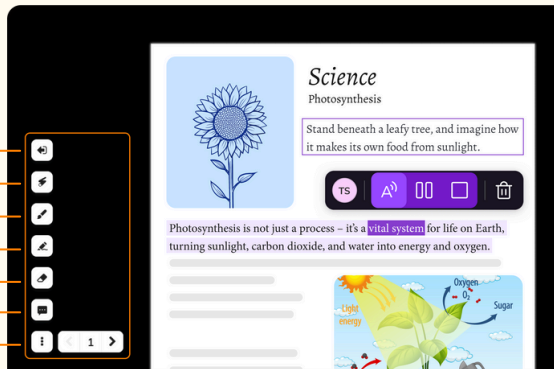
How to Use It:

- Click the  View icon
- Select **Presentation mode**




Available Tools in Presentation Mode:

- Exit Presentation Mode
- Laser Pointer
- Pencil
- Highlighter
- Eraser
- Hide/Show Comments
- Navigate between Pages

Open a Kami document with at least three pages, enter  Presentation Mode, and explore all available tools.

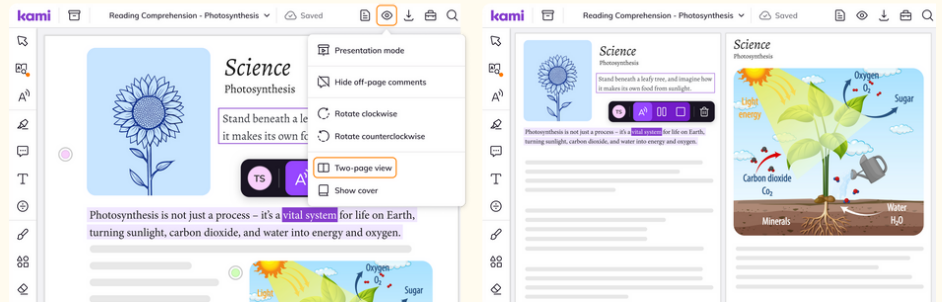
Two-Page View

What it Does:



Shows two pages side by side instead of a single page.

How to Use It:
