Word meanings

Tishrei: The first month of the civil year and the seventh month of the ecclesiastical year in the Hebrew calendar.

Judgement: In Judaism, people believe that God judges how good or bad people have been in order to decide their destiny in the afterlife.

Shofar: An ancient musical horn typically made of a ram's horn, used for Jewish religious purposes.

Selichot: Prayers for forgiveness.

Teshuvah: Means "to return." It is the attempt to return the soul to its original, pristine state.

Hashem: Is a title used in Judaism to refer to God.

New Year: Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish New Year.

Elul: The twelfth month of the Jewish civil year and the sixth month of the ecclesiastical year on the Hebrew calendar.

Kittel: A long white garment that men customarily wear

Synagogue: A Jewish house of worship.
