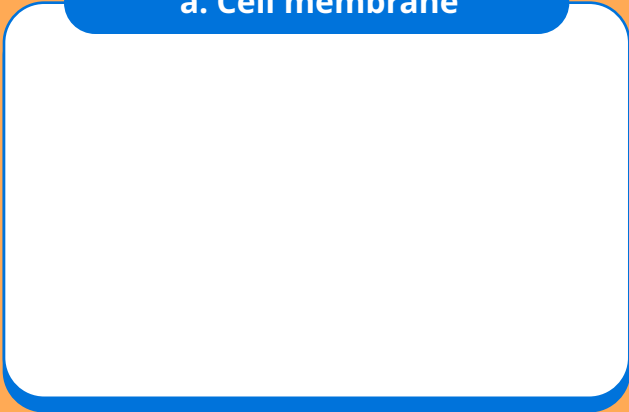
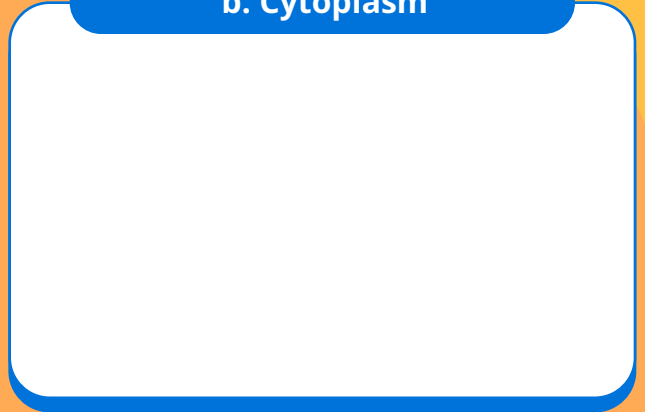


Find an example for each of the following:

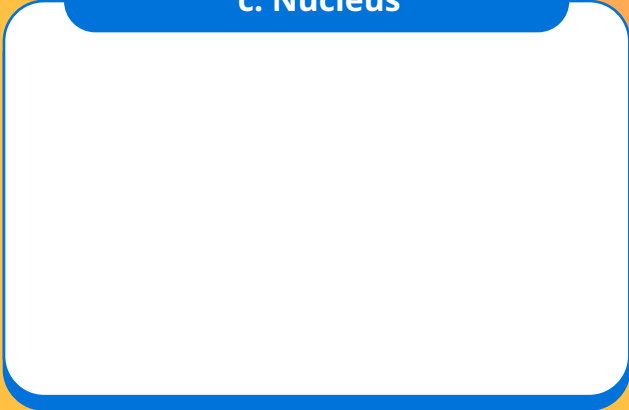
a. Cell membrane

A large, empty white rectangular box with rounded corners and a blue border, intended for a student to write an example of a cell membrane.

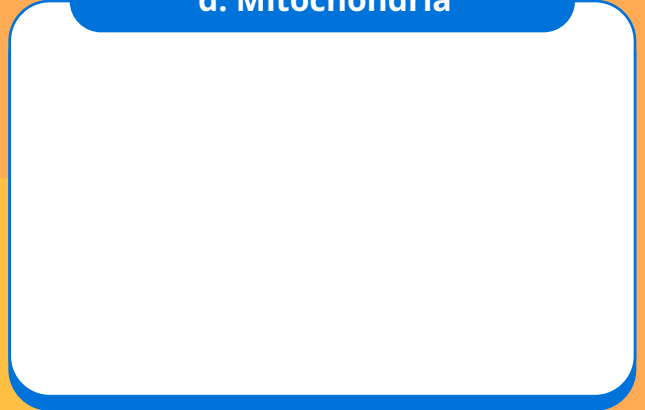
b. Cytoplasm

A large, empty white rectangular box with rounded corners and a blue border, intended for a student to write an example of cytoplasm.

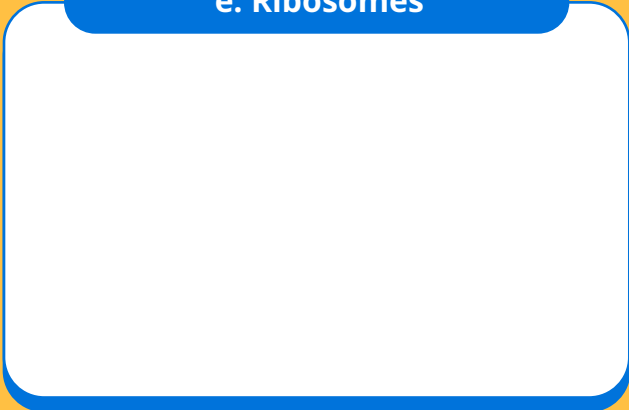
c. Nucleus

A large, empty white rectangular box with rounded corners and a blue border, intended for a student to write an example of a nucleus.

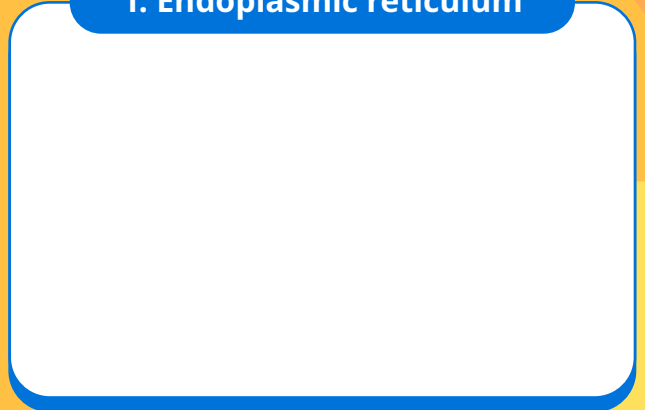
d. Mitochondria

A large, empty white rectangular box with rounded corners and a blue border, intended for a student to write an example of mitochondria.

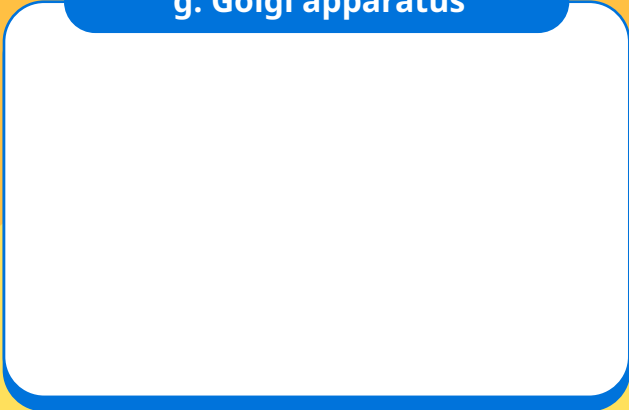
e. Ribosomes

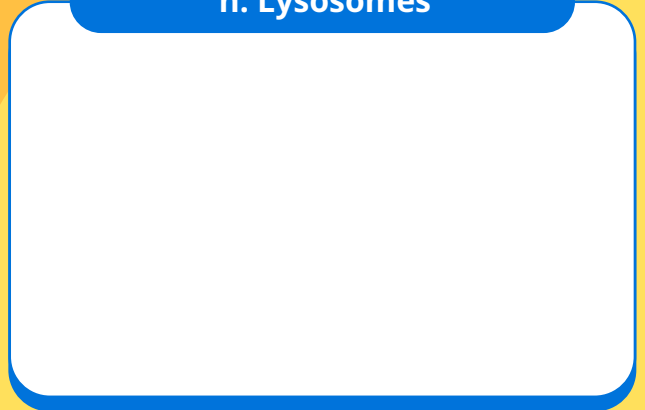
f. Endoplasmic reticulum
