Click the  **Annotation Summary** icon

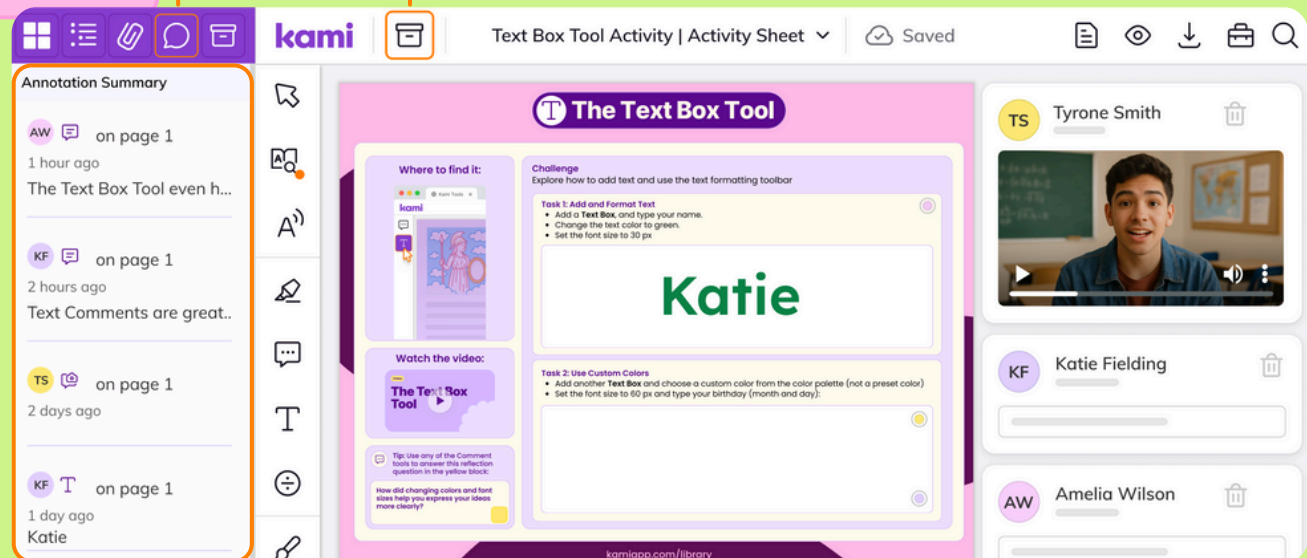
