

Spreading the 'five star hippy'
experience from the beaches to the ski
fields - and recreating what luxury
means in the process

As a trailblazer in the global hospitality industry, John Spence sees himself more as an entertainer than a businessman. In the early '80s, John cut his teeth as a music agent in London representing bands such as Culture Club, the Eurythmics and Bananarama before moving into property sales and marketing where he found a true calling. The entrepreneurial chairman and founder of Karma Royal Group now has an impressive portfolio of brands under rapidly expanding and multiaward winning global Karma Group – Karma Resorts, Karma Retreats, Karma Royal, Karma Estates, Karma Sanctum, Karma Beach, Karma Spa and Karma Boutique – so clearly, he is not a bad businessman either.

John has been honoured by the Yale University School of Architecture by being appointed the Edward P. Bass Distinguished Visiting Architecture Fellow. Through the fellowship, distinguished leaders in the development community from the public as well as

the private sector, such as John, participate as integral teaching members in Yale University's advanced studios and seminars. "It is a tremendous honour to have been the Edward P. Bass Distinguished Visiting Architecture Fellow at Yale University," said John. "To excel in a given field, you have to love what you do. I thoroughly enjoyed sharing my passion for seeking, recognising and realizing opportunities in some of the most diverse global environments with the students." A book was published through the University about his work with students developing a bodega and related tourism facilities in the Rioja region of Spain.

The University of California (UCLA) has honoured John by awarding him Distinguished Visiting Fellowships in the Department of Architecture and Urban Design. Included in the course work that John presented at the Advanced Topic Studio, "The Island, the Pods and the Glamorous – Contemporary Glamping in Remote Settings" incorporated key finishing touches of actual



resorts planned by Karma Resorts. During his tenure in the position in 2017, John and Georgina Huljich of P-A-T-T-E-R-N-S Architecture tasked 14 masters students to design an approximately 40 room hotel for a piece of land in Mykonos, Greece, owned by Karma Group. During the course of his Distinguished Visiting Fellowship, John worked closely with the students as they developed their ideas, including helping organize an immersive research trip to Mykonos. "I have been pleased to be invited to participate as a Distinguished Visiting Fellow at UCLA," said John. "I enjoyed my experience as the Edward P. Bass Distinguished Fellow at Yale University and was greatly and honoured that a second top-tier American University awarded me a Fellowship."

John's commitment to sharing his knowledge and experience has recently seen him working with students from the University of Pennsylvania, inspiring them to design plans for a chateau development in Carcassonne. A natural teacher, John has spent his professional life identifying like-minded talent from around the world and inspiring them to become the great entrepreneurs of tomorrow.

In 2016, John and Karma Group announced a joint venture with Mark Fuller, hotel legend and CEO of Sanctum Hotel Group to develop a series of authentic luxury rock styled and orientated hotels in strategic locations around the world, accompanied by an

exclusive private membership club. Spence and Fuller have identified a huge gap in the market for this style of hotel, which will combine the credibility and glamour of being frequented by rock royalty and music industry management. Plans have been developed to build Karma Sanctum Bali, joining Karma Sanctum Soho in London and Karma Sanctum on the Green, Royal Berkshire, in the English countryside.

John Spence has the unique talent to break down as yet unseen barriers, whether spotting and acquiring land in areas still undiscovered that later become global hot spots, from Goa to Uluwatu Bali to Gili Meno, to creating a new five star experience and brand philosophy that has changed what staying in a five star resort means. Now famously referred to as the "Five Star Hippy" lifestyle, Karma clients flock to the experience and other brands aspire to achieve it.

In 1993, when John visited Goa, India, he simply knew he'd found the place where he wanted to develop his first resort property. Purely using a cash injection from his life savings, John founded Royal Resorts to pioneer vacation ownership in India and South East Asia and began by developing their first Resort - The Royal Goan Beach Club in Cavellosim Goa. That was a huge success and diversification outside India followed with projects in Bali and Lombok, Indonesia, Gold Coast of Australia, Chiang Mai and Phuket in Thailand.



"Your work has got to be taken seriously and earn you money, but it's also got to be like sport – fun, challenging and something you do for enjoyment," he says. "If it becomes just about feeding the family then you're not going to enjoy it. And if it's not enough of a job, then really it's not going to be fulfilling. It's a balance.

I genuinely feel that my work is an adventure, every day."

Sensing the need to diversify, in 2002 John founded Karma Resorts and introduced the concept of boutique villa resorts in Asia, allowing clients to purchase freehold villas. John's vision for Karma Resorts pioneered the luxurious private pool villa experience, offering expansive holiday residences with access to five-star amenities and memorable experiences ranging from holistic healing retreats to hedonistic wine tastings – further pushing the "Five Star Hippy" ideal. John's philosophy that life is a celebration permeates his companies and this cultivated lifestyle is recognized by consistently achieving the industry's top accolades.

In many ways, John sees the parallels between work and sport. He is a passionate sports fan with his company currently sponsoring the England Men's Rugby Sevens team. This includes all ten legs of the HSBC Sevens World Series, the Gold Coast Commonwealth Games in 2018, including a training camp at Karma in Bali, and the 2018 Rugby World Cup Sevens in San Francisco. England Rugby players can often be seen 'recuperating' by the pool at John's properties. In 2017, Karma Resorts and Karma Group announced a three-year sponsorship of Rosslyn Park HSBC National Schools Sevens, the world's largest school rugby tournament, where they launched a fantastic competition for all Rosslyn Park HSBC National Schools Sevens Tournament schools to win the chance to be coached by a former England Player or Coach in the run up to the 2017 tournament,

plus a one week team training camp in a 5-star Karma Resort in Bali. Further cementing its commitment to sports as well as to Rottnest Island and Western Australian Tourism, Karma Group has the naming rights sponsorship of the iconic Rottnest Channel Swim. The iconic sporting event is now known as the Karma Resorts Rottnest Channel Swim.

A former winner of the Ernst and Young World Entrepreneur Of The Year Australia Award, John has also been a member of the award's global judging panel. Being recognized as a leader by his entrepreneurial peers across all industries worldwide is testament to John's relentless pursuit of the next great challenge. In February 2018, John was awarded Entrepreneur Of The Year at the 2018 Perspective Magazine Awards announced at the GNEX Conference in Florida.

A Commissioner on the West Australian Tourism Board from 2006 until 2010 and supporter of numerous charities, John was awarded 'Philanthropist of the Year' by the American Resort Developers' Association (ARDA) in 2006. John founded the Group in Bangalore, India and since 1993 has been supporting Christel House, a learning centre for disadvantaged children in Bangalore, which now also supports schools in Venezuela, Mexico City and South Africa. In that time, John's company has donated more than US\$1 million to them, making Karma Group one of the biggest donors in India. The core premise of 'Karma' is

one John avidly believes in and since Bangalore was the location of the first city centre office for his company, it is no accident that he gives a helping hand to the local community.

His charitable work in Bali through the Bali Life Foundation reflects his respect and love for the Balinese people and this extends to several other organisations on the island as well. Karma Kandara sponsored Puspadi Bali's classical music concert in 2015, donating a fabulous stay at the resort in the charity auction. Established in 1999, Puspadi Bali is dedicated to empowering people with disabilities through rehabilitation and education. Karma Group also supports the Children's Hope In Action (CHIA) in Vietnam.

Each year, John leads the Penguin Walk, a 30-kilometre hike winding through the hills, fields, forests and beaches near the coast of St. Tropez in France. John's vision is for the Walk to be a fun, challenging and purposed-filled adventure, fully embracing the mission of improving the lives of the disadvantaged, especially in communities around the world where Karma Group operates. The walk has raised over GBP 40,000 over the last four years for Christel House - enough to place three of their rising academic stars through full university scholarships.

Currently, John oversees three global divisions; Asia

and Australia; India and Middle East; and Europe and Caribbean. The company has zero debt or leverage and is still 100% owned by John. It is the market leader in its field and is poised for dramatic growth with future projects providing a global reach and an array of distinctive destinations beyond any other boutique hotel group in the world today.

John Spence has spent his professional life identifying like-minded talent from around the world and welcoming them to the Karma Group team, gathering a dynamic group of independent thinkers who remain unfettered by a traditional approach and who think of the Karma Group as their own - from his graduate architecture students at Yale and UCLA, to the local employees at any Karma Group resort around the world.

"We strive as a company to embody the celebration of life, inspired by beauty and style, fitness and health, in the world's most beautiful locations," said John. "This, in turn, inspires our loyal, alpha lifestyle driven guests from all over the world who, much like our team at Karma Group, relish challenging themselves by working hard and playing even harder."

The future looks bright as John Spence and Karma Group continue to set industry benchmarks driven by his passion and innovation in providing new products to engage its over 60,000 members and loyal clients all over the globe.

Created in 2002 to offer a high-end luxury villa resort experience in Asia, with five Karma Resorts located in Australia, Germany, Italy and Indonesia (2). Karma Group operates the following products: Karma Resorts: Five-star luxury with a laid back vibe. The Bali boutique villa resorts offer private pools, designer décor, gourmet dining and bespoke activities, from wine tasting to water sports.

Karma Group started the Karma Resort concept following the identification of a gap in the high-end leisure resort market to provide a product that offered luxury lifestyle accommodation of scale, for all the family, with a seamless service experience from arrival, right through to departure. In doing so, the Company is also able to enhance the attractiveness of the entire vacation ownership product range. The properties are operated as hotels using inventory from villa sales and fractionals.

Karma Villas: These are top-end 2-5 bedroom villas, each with a private swimming pool. These properties sell as title-based real estate, typically, between \$500K and \$5m, and are marketed to HNWI's (High Net Worth Individuals). The Company leases (or receives in a pool) the properties and utilises them as hotel inventory. Profits are shared with owners either through rental pool agreements or guaranteed return arrangements. Substantial expansion potential as disposable incomes in Asia and aspiration for luxury leisure increase.

Karma Estates is Karma Group's elite collection of properties in the world's most exclusive destinations. These beacons of style and sophistication are tailored to a new generation of luxury.







Melding the best in luxury with a selection of hedonistic pleasures, Karma Sanctum promises guests access to an exclusive world of parties, concerts and private gatherings.



























KARMA ROYAL PALMS




KARMA ROYAL CANDIDASA

Lovers of food may want to book a session at Candidasa's very own Indonesian cooking school and learn the secrets of Balinese cuisine.







If all you want to do is relax, then MonteRio's luxurious rooms, a great spa and signature restaurant means you'll never have - or want - to leave.








KARMA ROYAL JIMBARAN
