




Educator Training


Workshop Facilitation

KidWind has facilitated over 1,000 in-person workshops over the last 16 years. Our data shows that 83% of teachers who attend a KidWind workshop try out these new materials in their classrooms. These trainings broaden educators’ knowledge of renewables, explore project-based pedagogies, and provide details about participating in the KidWind Challenge. In addition, we give out hundreds of dollars worth of renewable energy classroom materials and kits at these trainings.

Funding in support of one workshop facilitation will allow for the following:



Planning and facilitating one full day workshop for 20 educators exploring project-based curriculum and pedagogies



Distribution of solar and/or wind starter kits and other classroom materials to each teacher

Site-Based	\$2,500	\$2,500 per workshop	Facilities, custodial, security, and transportation costs related to the event site
Workshop Facilitation	\$950	\$500 travel; \$450 facilitation	\$500 travel and lodging for facilitator; 6 hours at \$75 per hour for 1 facilitator
Material Distribution	\$2,000	\$100 in materials per teacher	Wind and solar starter kits, plus activity guides, for each teacher.
Instructional Support	\$300	10 hours at \$30 an hour	10 hours of instructional support to teachers in the form of mentorship, and email, phone, and video communication provided by local REcharge Instructors
Food	\$200	\$10 per teacher	Coffee and lunch for attendee
Administration Fee	\$50	1 hour of support at \$50 per hour	KidWind administration including: communication, assigning instructors, managing registrations and compiling reports
