Statement of Purpose


It is the mission, duty and purpose of Socos Labs to improve the development of children in need through the provision of an education product, Muse.


Socos Labs is a newly founded organization dedicated to "maximizing human potential" by distributing Muse for free to underserved communities.

About Muse

Muse is based on decades of research and is a solution for the education system's shortcomings. Muse is comprised of assessment technologies aligned with life outcomes to facilitate the development of more robust and general meta-learning skills.

Muse draws from a continuous stream of data naturally embedded within everyday experiences including parent-child conversations, student-produced artifacts; digital and audio capture of student-faculty interactions, and online collaborations.

The algorithms provide formative assessment linking dynamic, automated predictions with actionable feedback. Such information connects future possibilities with current realities via concrete recommendations for immediate actions, as well as longer-term perspective shifts and course corrections.
