- Belle Isle Station is located just north of downtown Oklahoma City and is anchored by Nordstrom Rack, Ross, Old Navy, Walmart, and Ulta.
- Belle Isle Station is immersed in a high-energy daytime population. Nearby employers include: Chesapeake energy HQ (4,000 employees), INTEGRIS Health (6,000 employees), State of Oklahoma (42,400), Cox Communications (1,400 employees), and Midfirst Bank (1,150 employees).
- Belle Isle Station is at the junction between several critical interstate corridors including Northwest Expressway and Route 66, the city's main east/west byway connecting Interstate 44 to both the Centennial Expressway and I-35. Traffic frequently exceeds 100,000 vehicles per day.
