# NO CHANGES TO THE DRAW

## ABCRA RULES page 43

### CD. 5 DRAWS

#### 5.1 Draw Order

The draw once completed is final and not subject to change

(a) The Committee reserves the right to make a draw change if the competitor is a committee member or attending to committee matters then the committee can issue a new draw number or place them at the end of the draw as required.

#### 5.2 Events that are split (eg Maiden A & B)

Entries will be allocated as equally as possible over the A & B events.

Competitors that have multiple entries will be entered into both A & B. Once drawn in the A or B or both, competitors are not to be changed from the A to the B or vice versa or consolidated into A or B. The only exemptions are for a judge that is judging one of these events and competing in the other or for committee members working with the cattle supply.

#### 5.3 Horse substitution

The rider may substitute a new horse in place of a drawn horse that is injured post draw providing the horse is eligible for the event. The right to accept or reject a substitute horse is at the sole discretion of the committee. Competitors may be required to show proof of injury by the committee eg. Vet certificate.

#### 5.4 Missed runs

If a competitor misses their run after being called they will be scratched. Only if a rider can show just cause as to why they missed their run the committee in its sole discretion may allow the competitor to run at the end of the draw. If the competitor

is a committee member or attending to committee matters then the committee can issue a new draw
