- Someone who is innovative, determined and inspired by the concept of not only raising funds for the CLF Charities, but raising awareness of the public about the Charities and how the funds raised are spent and how this benefits those who receive support.
- Someone who is prepared to step up and be an active member of a committee, potential office holders of committees, be part of changes and progress and who is truly passionate about making a difference in our industry.
- Someone who shows initiative, creativity, commitment to their task and who is able to collaborate
 with others, listen to their views and ideals and work with them to achieve the best outcome for the
 group.
- Someone who can recognise a conflict of interest in certain situations and declare that interest and step back for the greater good of the group.
- Someone who can go with the flow, accept changes on the run, think on their feet and find solutions in a quick, no fuss manner when problems or obstacles arise. It is for this reason the CLF YAQ do not have a strict and regimented scheduled. Nutrien is a live event and live means, change from one hour or minute to the next, we often need to make last minute changes to our plans that may have been in place for months prior to the event.
