World Championship Campdraft will be run in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of The Australian Bushmen's Campdraft & Rodeo Association Ltd (ABCRA). The RAS will keep you informed of any changes to competitions or scheduling whenever practicable. If due to COVID-19 some competitions are cancelled or postponed, the RAS will refund all entry fees and associated competition fees (such as stabling, parking and accommodation ordered via the RAS where applicable), however all other costs (such as hotel accommodation, or costs of the preparation of the Exhibit) must be covered by the Exhibitor.

GENERAL Selection Guidelines for World Championship Campdraft

- Up to the top 5 placed riders from the previous SRES World Championship Campdraft
- Up to the highest placed 5 Riders from the ABCRA Open National Standings as at the closing date of for entries, in the current points year
- ABCRA Champion Lady Rider in the current points year
- Previous Warwick Gold Cup Winner
- Previous Canning Downs Winner
- Previous Paradise Lagoons Open Draft Winner
- Leading Australian Campdraft Association Open Rider as at the closing date of for entries, in the current points year
- Leading Southern Campdraft Association Champion Rider as at the closing date of for entries, in the current points year
- Leading Gippsland Campdrafting Association Open Championship Competitor as at the closing date of for entries, in the current point's year.
- The RAS may select wildcard competitors should it see fit to do so.

The RAS may consider invitations to those further down any list of standings if those above them are already offered a place, have declined an invitation or for any other reason as they see fit.

- (i) Agree to be bound by the competition rules found in the RAS General Regulations and the Special Regulations of this Competition;
- (ii) Warrant that the information I have provided is true and correct to the best of my knowledge; and
- (iii) Certify that the Exhibit/s belongs to me, or is under my control with permission of the Owner.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: 1. All Persons riding a horse must wear approved safety helmets to the current Australian, European, British or American Standard whilst mounted, including but not limited to Competition and exercise arenas (unless otherwise specified). The restraining helmet harness must be secured and fastened at all times. Only helmets bearing one or more of the following standards are accepted: AS/NZS 3838 (current Australian Standard) provided they are SAI Global marked, ARB HS 2012 provided they are SAI Global marked, VG1 (01.040: 2014-12) with or without BSI Kitemark, PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) provided they are BSI Kitemarked, ASTM F1163 (current US Standard) and SNELL E2001. It is the Exhibitors' responsibility to ensure that they are wearing the correct helmet, however should the RAS deem the helmet worn is not of appropriate standard, or the Exhibitor is not wearing a helmet, the Exhibitor will be asked to dismount immediately. 2. All horses entered in competitive Classes must be microchipped and have that chip recorded with a recognised National Registry. 3. It shall be the responsibility of each Competitor to meet their fares and freight charges for their horse. It shall also be the responsibility of each Competitor to provide feed and bedding for their horse. 4. A Competitor shall be restricted to the use of one horse throughout the relevant Campdraft Competitions. The Stewards may, at their discretion, grant permission for the replacement of a horse which has been injured, provided that the application for replacement is accompanied by a certificate from a Veterinary surgeon. 5. Conditions of the Competition for all events shall be as decided by the Horse Section Committee. 6. The Committee reserves the right to include any rider in any events should it be found necessary. 7. Competitors will be obliged to use saddle and equipment approved by the Society, this being in accordance with the rules of the ABCRA, under which these contests are run. 8. It shall be compulsory for a Competitor to ride in all events for which he has nominated, except by presentation of a medical certificate or as determined by the Committee. 9. Rules - the events in this section will be run in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Australian Bushmen's Campdraft and Rodeo Association Ltd (ABCRA).
