All Amateur competitors must hold a current financial Amateur or Select permit with the AQHA, or the equivalent issued by their relevant breed organisation. The permit must match the registered breed of horse the Amateur/Select is exhibiting. A permit issued by the HSAA only can be used if the breed Association, recognised by the AQHA does not issue Amateur/Select permits to compete in Amateur/Select Amateur classes.

If your program application is approved, you will receive an approval letter from the AQHA.

Show Results, any Accident Reports and Complaint Reports must be returned to AQHA in such time that they will be postmarked no later than 14 days after the closing day of the show.
