Prior to selling your mare, you may decide to retain a breeding right to this mare for future use, you will be required to fill out this form in its entirety and keep on file.

It is also recommended that you have a contract of sale for your mare that stipulates the condition of a Retained Breeding right. This mare maybe sold on in the future and you need to clarify that:

- a) your contract covers this situation;
- b) the owner of said mare will disclose to the new owner your retained breeding right; and
- c) if there is a time limit on the use of your retained breeding rights

When you are applying for registration of the progeny, pertaining to this retained breeding right, you will have to send this form with the registration application. This means that you will be recorded as the breeder of this foal.
