





he undeniably iconic Australian equine sport of Campdrafting got its roots in the late 1800s when stockmen, keen to prove who had the fastest and most talented horse on a cow, began to compete against each other, with more than likely, a few bets thrown into the ring. From that humble beginning, and 130 years odd years later, the sport continues to grow.

With a Quarter horse's speed and their desire to work a cow, Campdrafting is an event they are well suited for. The Warwick Gold Cup, hosted by the Warwick Show and Rodeo Society, in Warwick,





# AQHA INCENTIVES and the WARWICK GOLD CUP



Queensland, is known by many as the 'Melbourne Cup' of Campdrafting. The event attracts more competitors and offers more prize money than any other campdraft in the country. The weekend is action-packed, exciting and a lot of fun!

But what is the AQHA awarding that is motivating more Quarter horse owners, riders and breeders to chase the Warwick Gold Cup?

# AQHA INCENTIVES and the WARWICK GOLD CUP

The AQHA have been involved with the Warwick Gold Cup Campdraft since the late 1990's. Early on, the AQHA presented a buckle to the highest placed registered Quarter Horse, but the cash incentive now offered is motivating more and more members to give Campdrafting a go with their Quarter horses.

The concept behind the AQHA offering the incentive is to promote the Australian Quarter Horse in the discipline of Campdrafting, by rewarding competing AQHA members and registered horses with cash incentives. This has created a lot of awareness of the Quarter Horse in Australia, while encouraging owners to renew or join the association.

**ELIGIBILITY & PAYMENTS:** 'To be eligible for each AQHA Incentive, horses must be AQHA registered and shown under their full registered name, and owners and breeders must be financial members of the AQHA at the time of event. Any payments will be paid to the financial Owner, and the financial Breeder of each awarded horse. If there is a tie, money will be split evenly between the winners.'

# **WARWICK GOLD CUP**

# AQHA \$1000 INCENTIVE: HIGHEST SCORING QUARTER HORSE

This award goes to the Financial Owner of the horse.

WINNER: Darrin Jones - Owner and rider of Players Garter Q-78042

This AQHA \$1,000 Incentive was won by Darrin Jones and Players Garter, Q-78042. The pair totalled an aggregate score of 264.5 to take a well-deserved 3rd place, and it certainly gave him a buzz!

'We did it!' Darrin said. 'We placed third in the Warwick Gold Cup 2019! I was so happy to go home in the Top 3 from 836 competitors, and to win the AQHA Incentive was a great bonus!'

Players Garter, a Rey's Ya Garter gelding, was purchased through the 2016 Landmark Sale, and in 2017, placed 2nd in both the Landmark Classic Challenge & Campdraft. In the 2019 Warwick Gold Cup, he ran the 2nd top score in the Final of the 2019 Warwick Gold Cup (89) to place 3rd overall, and just an amazing one point off the lead!

So, from the AQHA, a massive congratulations goes out to Darrin and Players Garter! From over 800 strong competitors, the duo not only pulled together an outstanding performance, but showcased the versatile attributes of our Quarter horse breed.

# The Australian Quarter Horse Association honours Heather & Lionel Richardson with induction into the Hall of Fame.

# 2000 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

# Lionel & Heather Richardson

he involvement of Lionel and Heather Richardson commenced in 1965 with the purchase of two infused geldings by "King" a first cross stallion by VAQUERO Q-1. They were so impressed with these two geldings that they purchased a yearling colt to PRONTO MIO Q-4. This colt was destined to become a household name with working Quarter Horse enthusiasts.

In 1966 they purchased another colt, TOM DOOLEY R2-30 who also was highly successful in the early years of Quarter Horse competition. With the aim of breeding purebred stock, in 1967 they purchased the mare CEELIE R2-33 whose first foal for the Richardson's was PINE HILLS QUARTER MOON Q-152, born in 1968.

Lionel and Heather were charter members of the Australian Cutting Horse Association which was formed in 1969 in Brisbane. In this year, the first foals by CATTLEMAN R1-236 out of the Richardson's well respected line of station mares were born.

Lionel and Heather showed both CATTLEMAN and

TOM DOOLEY at the first Cutting Futurity held at Brookfield in Queensland in 1970.

In 1971 the Richardson's started the Roma Cutting and Roping Association (being the inaugural President and Secretary). This Club sponsored the first cutting clinic with noted American trainer, Pine Johnson.

Lionel accepted the position of President of the South East Queensland Quarter Horse Association in 1972. In a short period of time, he turned this Association into an active financial Association. Lionel and Heather attended the first meeting of the Australian Quarter Mile Racing Association and were later active members of the Queensland Sprint Racing Association. Even though they never owned a sprint racer, they actively supported any Association which would promote Quarter Horses.

In 1973 the Richardson's headed to Victoria to compete in the Victorian Circuit of shows with

### CATTLEMAN and TOM DOOLEY.

This year also saw the running of the Australian Horseman's Congress held at Gatton College. As part

of this Congress, Heather initiated a meeting between the Australian Cutting Horse Association and the National Cutting Horse Association. It was because of her involvement with the calling of this meeting that Robert Baldwin (who chaired the meeting), credits Heather with being the founder of the present NCHA. As a result of this meeting and an indication of the high esteem with which Heather was held by the early pioneers of Cutting in Australia, Heather and the Richardson's Solicitor were flown to Moree to construct the Constitution of the NCHA.

Between 1974 and 1980 Lionel was an AQHA Board member. In 1978 he chaired a meeting called to set up the Queensland Quarter Horse Association, the first State Association in Australia. Lionel and Heather stayed active members of the executive of this Association for many years and assisted in the organization and running of two successful Quarter Horse sales at Brookfield.


From 1978 until 1984 Heather, in conjunction with Marlene Allanson, produced the QQHA Newsletter, which was sent to every financial member of the AQHA in Queensland. During this time Heather wrote a column in the AWH Magazine and had numerous articles published in the QH Magazine.

In 1980 the South Western Queensland QHA commenced and Lionel was the inaugural President with Heather as the inaugural Secretary.

Between 1983 and 1992 Heather organised and Lionel chaired the meeting from which the T&DQHA was formed. They both held various positions in this Club such as President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Publicity Officer. They assisted the AQHA Executive Director, Kevin Norris, with the organisation and running of an AQHA Convention held in Toowoomba.

Heather and Lionel also organised a Sprint Race to be run on a Toowoomba Racetrack as part of the convention. They were responsible for the running of two successful Quarter Horse sales in Toowoomba.

In 1984 they sold "Pine Hills" at Wallumbilla to semiretire to Crows Nest, Queensland. At the time of the sale, the Richardson's had 200 registered Quarter Horses including their six stallions; CATTLEMAN R1-236, TOM DOOLEY R2-30, PINE HILLS QUARTER MOON Q-152, TALK OF THE TOWN Q-375, COMMANDER STAR Q-1009 and the youngster PINE HILLS INTREPID R2-8225.





# What do weanlings need...

WEANLINGS ARE FIRSTLY TO KEEP IT SIMPLE AND SECOND,
NOT TO OVER- OR UNDER-FEED.

ecause feeds and feeding management are linked to behavioural problems, growth abnormalities, immunity, gastrointestinal conditions and a whole range of equine clinical problems, a few simple dos and don'ts can help prevent problems.

Several unwanted behaviours are strongly linked to feeds and feeding strategies. Crib-biting has not been reported in feral or free-living domestic horses, but it has been observed when Przewalski horses are kept in captivity, suggesting that some management practices can cause the behaviour. In one study of foal behaviour, 42 out of 186 foals developed abnormal oral behaviour - wood-chewing, cribbiting or both - after weaning.

Some ceased wood-chewing and cribbiting as they matured, but often once a foal develops these behaviours, they tend to become fixed and can become excessive. One foal was observed cribbiting for nearly 50% of its daily activity, biting for 30 seconds every 5 minutes for 22 hours a day – or 1470 crib-bites a day. Wood-chewing often precedes or is associated with crib-biting and has been found in 30% of young horses and 74% of wood-chewers became crib-biters.

Other work has shown that crib-biting is increased by a low-forage or high-starch/grain diet, often peaks 4 to 8 hours after a grain meal and that feeding grain-based feeds after weaning resulted in a four-fold increase in risk. Grain-based and high starch diets have also been linked with increased stress, aggressive behaviour, stomach ulcers and coprophagy.

Both before and after weaning, foals on a fibre-oil supplement show less stress (lower heart rates and lower blood cortisol - the stress hormone) when compared to those on grain-starch-sugar feeds - suggesting that avoiding sugarystarchy feedstuffs helps foals cope with the stress of weaning. In weanling feeding trials, foals given an oil-fibre supplement tended to be more relaxed, spent more time grazing, less time pacing, had reduced fearfulness and reactivity (to the 'surprise test') and spent more time investigating (the 'novel object test') than those on a grain-based, high starch supplement.

The investigative behaviour studied in the 'novel object test' involves a bright blue and orange plastic child's tricycle, wooden intermittently quacking ducks, bright tarpaulins and colourful twirling golf umbrellas; the surprise test involves striped umbrellas suddenly opening or being lowered from the ceiling in front of the weanling while it's eating. By measuring the time it took to approach and investigate the 'novel' objects, the distance the foals fled upon being confronted with a 'surprise', time taken to walk across an unfamiliar tarpaulin and the amount of time taken to return to their feedbin, researchers assess calmness and reactivity. Fearful animals shift their attention away from the task (resulting in poor performance), while less reactive weanlings learn faster and completed handling tests in a shorter time because they were less nervous and distracted. These results persisted when measured again at 9-10 months of age.

Another study assessed temperament and tractability of 17 foals from the age of 2 to 40 weeks and on a grain-starch feed or an oil-fibre diet. The differences were apparent within hours after weaning. The foals on the oil-fibre diet were less distressed, calmer and more inquisitive immediately after weaning.

At 2 months after weaning, they were less flighty; less reactive to pressure, noise and visual stimuli, more

likely to approach humans they didn't know; quicker to walk across an unfamiliar tarpaulin and had increased willingness to perform. Interestingly, when mares were fed in their last 4 months of pregnancy a fibre-oil supplement instead of grain-based starchy-sugary supplements (and this includes grain by-products such as bran, pollard, millrun and hominy meal), their unweaned foals showed similar investigative behaviour, less reactivity and fearfulness. The foals of mares fed grain-starch supplements during pregnancy had high blood glucose and insulin levels for up to 6 months after birth – and this has been linked to developmental orthopaedic conditions.

The connection between orthopaedic disease and insulin has been known since late last century. Sweet feeds and high grain-starch-sugar feeds increase the incidence of DOD through their effect on insulin, growth and thyroid hormones. There is thought to be a correlation between OCD and glucose intolerance in foals that are genetically predisposed and this is a current area of research.

When mares and foals are fed oil-fibre enriched diets instead of starchy grain-based feeds and supplements, the incidence of DOD is much lower.



# WHAT DO WEANLINGS NEED...

The term 'Developmental Orthopaedic Disease' (DOD) was coined at a symposium sponsored by the American Quarter Horse Association in 1986. It was used to describe any orthopaedic problem that involved tendon, joint or bone in growing horses. The diseases encompassed by this definition are osteochondrosis (OC), osteochondrosis dessicans (OCD), physitis and epiphysitis, angular limb deformities (ALD), flexural deformities (including contracted tendons) and wobblers (cervical vertebral malformation). Despite considerable research, there's no single cause for any of these.

Creep feeding became the norm after research in the 1960's into mares milk found that around 3 months after birth, the milk could no longer meet the requirements of the growing foal. High energy grain and supplements were often provided free-choice to mares and foals – and the first reports of unusual foal lameness began to appear in the veterinary literature.

Excess protein was blamed and this is still quoted today even though the theory has since been unequivocally and consistently discredited. Recent and ongoing studies into the high incidence of DOD have found the following risk factors: rapid growth from over-feeding; trauma to joint cartilage due to excess body weight; intermittent or irregular exercise; mineral imbalances; failure to accurately include sugar and starch from high-energy pastures; high sugar-starch (called NSC or non-structural carbohydrate) feeds.

Maximum growth is not compatible with optimum skeletal development. Optimum growth is the goal so a broad understanding of how and when weanlings and yearlings grow can help guide decisions on what and how to feed. Bone and muscle have their own windows of growth. The 3 most rapid growth periods for bone are: from 4 months before, until one month after birth; between 6-12 months of age, and just after puberty. The period of muscle growth - when the cells increase in size and number to achieve genetic potential – is between 2 and 24 months of age. Height is an indicator of bone growth whereas body weight and condition reflect muscle and fat deposition.

If nutrition is unbalanced or incorrect during these periods, the opportunity to achieve optimum muscle and bone development – and minimise the risk of future unsoundness – will be missed. The period of maximum risk for the development of skeletal abnormalities occurs when height and weight gain are









rapid ie from 4 months before until 12 months after birth.

The time course for hock and stifle OCD is different. Most hock lesions are generally present at 1 month of age and there is evidence they can develop during gestation, so correct feeding of the mare should be practised before and after birth. Stifle lesions appear between 3 and 5 months of age and there is a positive correlation between OC and weight gain in the 3rd to 5th months. The significance of this is that correct, sound bone growth (ie we are not focussing on muscle and cover at this age) must be the priority for the weanling.

There is a link between above average weight gains and onset of bone diseases. Muscle growth should not be pushed forward while the bones and joints are vulnerable. Excessive loading (usually due to excess body condition), an unbalanced diet or hard exercise affect the pattern of bone growth. Swelling and lameness of the stifles and hocks are more common in this age group. For growth to proceed in a balanced and synchronised way, any sign of lameness, filling in the legs or joints (including bone and bog spavins) or abnormal limb angles necessitates a cessation of exercise, a reduction in the energy in the diet and a veterinary examination. A lighter, leaner weanling with appropriate height (remember height is an indication of bone growth) is the ideal.

Whether weanling bone and muscle growth are optimised is also influenced by the quality and quantity of protein in the diet. Weanlings that don't have their needs met in terms of their protein - more specifically, their amino acid - requirements are shorter and fatter than those that do. Proteins are made of chains of amino acids - good quality protein is high in essential amino acids. In weanlings it is lysine and threonine that are most often deficient. Because every tissue (bone, muscle, red cells etc) has its own 'recipe' of amino acids, the number of new cells the body can build depends on the right ingredients being available.

Amino acids that can't be used because of deficiencies of other amino acids are converted to fat – and that's not what we're after at this age. The percent protein on the feed tag is of little use in terms of knowing whether it will meet the weanlings requirements, because horses don't need a % protein, they need a number of grams of protein each day. For example, a horse fed 3kg of a 10% protein feed, or 1½ kg of a 20% protein feed gets 300g of protein in both cases. So % protein is not useful in terms of knowing how much usable protein the diet provides. Soy and lucerne are

excellent sources of amino acids – so if they are in shortsupply or costly, save them for the weanlings ahead of any other horses.

Evaluation of growth requires assessment. Regular monitoring of weight, growth rate and height - using a measuring-stick, scales and/or 'condition scoring' - are sound practices. Exercise levels also affect growth and musculo-skeletal development, the final product of which is gait. Foals allowed free access to pasture have been shown to travel 16 to 25km each day and to gallop on average for about 3.5 minutes per 24 hours, divided into approximately 40 sprints. Exercise restriction, whether due to injury, mare illness or the environment, slows development and the diet should be reduced to provide little energy but meet protein (ie amino acid) and mineral needs.

The risk of fast, catch-up growth (and hence DOD) increases after weaning, or a period of restricted

exercise or diet, so it needs to be managed carefully. Excessive loading (usually due to excess body condition), an unbalanced diet or hard exercise - affect the pattern of bone growth. Foals gain 800-1000g per day and we want this to be bone and muscle, not fat. After weaning this falls to an average gain of 0.13kg a day. It may take several weeks for weanlings to resume their rapid growth and this period must be

managed carefully to maintain a slow and steady return to growth rate. Equally important, loss of the mare's milk may reduce the nutrients available for bone formation during the postweaning period and amino acids and mineral supply needs to be restored by the feed.

Other benefits of avoiding grain-based and high starch feeds and supplements are many. The newly weaned foal is particularly at risk for stomach acidity, early onset of ulceration and an increased risk for some types of colic. Slower stomach emptying and more acid-buffering by oily-fibrous food reduces stomach acid with its associated discomfort, ulcers and pain. Further down the intestinal tract in the caecum, fermentation and acid production from grain-based starch-sugar feeds is linked to aberrant oral behaviours such as wood-chewing, as well as some colics and diarrhoeas.

Crib-biting is associated with altered gut-transit time and gastric ulceration – stomach inflammation and ulcers were found in 60% of crib-biting foals compared to 20% of non-crib-biting foals – and they had more severe ulcers and inflammation upon initial endoscopic examination. Horses produce saliva (which buffers stomach acid) only when biting or chewing and its



thought that weanlings wood-chew or crib-bite in an attempt to stimulate additional saliva production.

Feeding 3-4 small feeds each day and providing a mix of hay and roughage types (include different hays, beet pulp, haylage and palatable, non-toxic branches and leaves where possible) increases feeding/chewing time and decreases weaving and nibbling behaviours.

# The most common problems with nutrition of foals and weanlings are from insufficient roughage and chewing

The most common problems with nutrition of foals and weanlings are from insufficient roughage and chewing; over or under feeding; sharp increases in rates of gain, and amino acid and mineral imbalances. The bottom line is to reach a happy medium - not too fat and not too thin. You don't want to see ribs but you do want to be able to feel them. So keep it simple by providing an oil-enriched vitamin, mineral and amino acid supplement. Free 24 hour access to roughage (pasture/hay) significantly reduces the occurrence of stomach ulcers in weanlings and vitamin E is important for immunity. With the exception of the neonatal period, foals are at their most vulnerable in the period after weaning. The immunity they received from the mare's colostrum has waned and their own immune system hasn't begun to reach peak efficiency. Vitamin E supplementation has been shown to increase both the killing-capacity of white blood cells and the immune response to vaccination.

Limit or better still, eliminate grains and grains-based feeds from their diet – remembering that feeds containing grain by-products such as millrun, pollard, bran, hominy meal etc can have dangerously high levels of starch.

# The buzz of showing is back! You're excited . . . but are you organised?

f course you're excited! You're back on the show circuit, in touch and competing with all your show buddies, and of course, meeting new AQHA members and competitors. It's a time to look forward to, maybe a fresh start with a new horse, discussing and seeing new foals and upcoming youngsters, or maybe to show off your own! You're thinking about what events you're going to focus on and finding it hard to curb your enthusiasm. If this sounds like you, then read on, plan ahead and make certain you're ready for the best show season ever!

Funds

As exciting as it is, before you can decide on which shows you'll be attending, you'll need to be realistic and make certain you're going to have the funds to cover the whole process. Showing horses is either part of your horse business or stud, or it's a lifestyle hobby. Either way, money comes into it.

The word 'budget', as horrible as it sounds, is something we all need to adopt in these times. Before planning to go showing, know the budget you'll be working with. Know where the money's going to come from and how much there'll need to be, week to week. If you run a horse business, you'll have already done your sums and from here on in, will just need to keep records of all your expenses and income. On the other hand, if showing is your hobby, sit down and work out how much you're going to need to feed your frenzy. It may help

to open a separate bank account and use it specifically for your expenses and any income (prizemoney, etc.) from your horse showing. It's an easy way to keep track of the financial side of things. Just a snippet of information; agricultural show prizemoney is always good, and it's an excellent way to promote Quarter horses to the public! Plan on making some extra income each week and deposit this extra cash into your 'Show Account'. The difference it'll make to your bank balance and show season will be amazing.

Shows

Mark all your show dates down on your planner or in your diary. Write in the contact phone number for each show. Contact them early for show programs, entry conditions and pre-entry deadlines.

If you intend on competing at the State or National shows, etc., get your entries in as early as possible. Set goals for the classes you intend on being really competitive in at these shows, and then plan your showing strategy from the start to mentally and physically prepare yourself and your horse.

Put some time into planning for these shows. They are major events on the calendar, meaning you could be away from home for more than a day or two. With this in mind, don't leave things until the last minute! Organise yourself early to have your property and any 'left at home' animals cared for while you're away.

# Vehicle & Float

There's nothing as bad as a breakdown on a busy highway when you're loaded up with horses and gear, not to mention any passengers. Take your vehicle and float along to your regular mechanic for a full engine, towing and safety check.

A wooden floor in your float, gooseneck or truck must be checked regularly, especially if it has rubber on top. Never neglect it! Drop into your local tyre dealer and have checks done on tyres, including the spares. Taking these precautions won't always guarantee smooth travelling anything can go wrong - but leave home prepared, just in case. Never ignore these important things.

Rule Books, Registration & Information

It's a must to always have your current AQHA Rulebook at every show, as you're required to adhere to the rules and regulations at all times.

There are likely to be rule changes or additions each year, so check for these and ensure all have been noted. Throughout the year, regularly go through your rulebook to keep rules fresh in your mind. Set up a special show folder containing all current and relevant information regarding the AQHA, all membership numbers, club memberships, horse registration papers and Amateur cards. Take it with you to every show. Just in case you're asked to produce any information.

Your Horse

Most horses will come back in from any break with a fresh mind and body and ready to work.

However, always ease your horse back into a regular routine of show feeding, exercise and training, gradually increasing the workload to suit the feed. It helps to get a regular vet check to be certain your horse is healthy and on his way back to being show fit. Is his vaccination and parasite control up to date? Be sure also to have your horse's teeth checked, as many conditioning or behavioural issues can be traced back to dental problems. Hooves should be regularly and neatly trimmed or shod and in a healthy condition. Check all rugs for broken clips and for any repairs needed. Regular and sensible rugging should be carried out to get his coat in top condition. If you plan to be out, or at work all day, rug according to the temperatures predicted.

Before the shows begin you may choose to send your horse to a trainer for a tune-up. If you're time poor this is a great option. It'll take some pressure off, allowing time to prepare for the busy show season. Alternatively, you may wish to attend some lessons, or a clinic or two. Whatever you decide, it all adds up to sensible preparation for horse and rider.

Tack

Ideally you keep your tack and show gear correctly stored, clean and dry.

Check all your tack regularly for wear and tear. Organise for any repairs if required. Clean and condition the leather, polish silver, and bag each one ready for travel, not forgetting your work and training gear. Check and clean your show and work saddle pads and leg protection boots for grime, sand and prickles. When packing for shows don't forget a couple of extra bridles, reins, halters, leads and bits.

Grooming Tools
Replace grooming tools or brushes that are past their use by date and check for anything that needs washing or replacing. Re-stock horse shampoo, conditioner, grooming products and fly repellent.

Make sure to buy hoof black and a white brightening product, for socks, blazes, or those light and white manes & tails! Have your clippers been cleaned since they were last used? If they need sharpening, get it done now! Oil and store them with your grooming tools. Clipper blades go blunt at the worst times, so it can pay to buy a spare set.

Show Clothes

Check your show clothes for broken stitching, stains, missing buttons and studs. Have them mended or DIY.

Check your chaps for any buckle, zipper or stitching problems. Check, clean and re-shape hats and store in a hatbox ready to pack. Clean and polish all silver, accessories such as show jewellery, chaps, boots and spurs. If you need to order new clothes or accessories, do it early so that you aren't disappointed.

Camping

Camping is all part of the fun of showing horses. When the competition and work is over for the day, the campfires start and time with good friends & family begins.

It can be a great time so make certain you're fully set up to stay overnight at shows. Plan and get yourself organised early to make sure you have all the basics for a comfortable overnight stay. Make a list of required camping items and use it every time.

Knowing that you're fully prepared for the show season will now leave your mind free to concentrate on the job at hand. That is watching, riding, showing and enjoying your Quarter horses.



# STATE SHOW





