



DOUBLE UP SHOW A BIG HIT

The Sydney Quarter Horse Association (SQHA), Mt Hunter, NSW - 2020 has been a year of hardship but true Australian resilience overcoming challenges was shown over the two-day SQHA SRAC Double Up Show at K Ranch in Mt Hunter, NSW.

Double the days, double the judges and double the points pulled in the largest group of riders in the Sydney region for this year.

With over 370 entries, 156 classes and 62 horses from across New South Wales and a large group of competitors drawn from Victoria, competitors participated in a COVID-safe and excellent show with open, beginner, novice amateur, amateur, select amateur and youth classes. The Double Up Show had a hugely positive economic impact to the region of over \$83,000. With double the prize money on offer from SQHA generous sponsors Stillwaters Stud and Nevillefail Ranch, the largest event of the day was the 'Di Hill Walk Jog' with a whopping 20 entries. Deserae Sim and RRD Ceeled With A Kiss from Judge Craig Rath and Karen Ferguson and RE Get Your Blaze On from Judge Tara Goring came out on top of this well supported and special event.

Joanne Gregory, Secretary of the Club said *"I thought it was great to see people back out enjoying their horse showing and so happy for each other's achievements in what has been a tough year for everyone. It was great that the Victorian competitors came up for the show and joined in the fun."*

"The competitors at the Double Up Show really exemplified the best in Aussie sportsmanship as folks had a go with new classes many haven't tried in over five

years, trainers and experienced riders giving tips and tricks to new riders and the overall positive community environment our competitors and spectators have created. A good show doesn't happen by itself; it takes a great deal of time and effort with our volunteers committing over 170 hours to set up, run and manage this particular show not including committee time. Our committee since August have implemented new procedures and methodologies to address and find solutions to issues in this COVID environment and committed a significant amount of time researching and coordinating with state and federal agencies so we can plan a great and COVID-safe show season. The key for a great show is a positive community of competitors and a strong spirit of volunteerism where people invest their time and experience to make a show great for everyone. But seeing the smiles and laughs and hearing the cheers by other competitors and spectators for riders achieving personal bests makes this a special club." Benjamin Gifford, President of the Club said.

The club also saw very positive results using their combined social media strategy, with a 120% increase in engagement with its nearly 2,000 Facebook members. With 22 posts, over 30 comments and nearly 300 reactions, the SQHA was able to harness both its Facebook and Instagram page to get great stories from their competitors to their entire community and get show sponsors to an engaged and active group of members.

SQHA recommends to other AQHA clubs to try using social media on the day of the show to give on the

fly updates and build engagement encouraging competitors to actively share their own stories and positive comments or feedback. With competitor generated posts plus on the fly updates, it builds a great community culture that helps reinforce a great time for everyone.

The next SQHA show (AA Approved) will be Summer Dreams on the 30th and 31st of January 2021 at K Ranch, Mt Hunter, NSW. The SQHA is also the host and organiser for the 2021 NSW State Quarter Horse Championship, the premier quarter horse event in the state, happening in March 2021.

WE WOULD LIKE TO TAKE A LOOK BACK ON THE HISTORY OF THE

GREGORY PAUL LOUGHER

1915 - 1986

1997 HALL
OF FAME
INDUCTEE



The Australian Quarter Horse Association honours Gregory Lougher with induction into the Hall of Fame.

Greg Lougher was born in California. A keen athlete, he won the San Francisco 100 metre Swimming Championship and was the first intercollegiate rodeo champion riding for the University of California at Davis where he was studying to become a vet.

Before going to Davis, Greg spent a few years running wild horses, breaking them in and selling them; driving the big teams of horses making hay and competing at Rodeos to make enough money to go to College. His studies were interrupted when he was called up to serve in the Army during World War II. He was an instructor in horseshoeing, riding and shooting. He was first out of 5,000 men in marksmanship. He was stationed in China, India and Burma with the U.S. Cavalry and the mule regiment where he was assigned to Merrills Marauders. They had to pack guns and ammunition through swamps, mined jungles and parts of the Himalayas. Greg had to keep the mules on their feet and he was able to build a foot with packing, Stockholm tar and a makeshift shoe when necessary. His brief veterinarian training and his experience in Asia just added to his skills as a horseman.

After the War, Greg started training horses professionally. He started with Thoroughbreds, and then showed and trained hunters, jumpers, American Saddlebreds and

Tennessee Walkers. He schooled polo ponies, drove trotters and showed and trained California Bridle horses and was one of the first cutting horse trainers in California. Greg was said to be the best Hackamore reinsman of his time and his skill with the hackamore endeared him to Luis Ortega, the world's foremost rawhide craftsman, who showed Greg some of his secrets. Greg made many hackamores with a feel that only someone with his touch could do. His work is still respected.

Greg Lougher received the Silver Medal from the SPCA (RSPCA) for his act of bravery in swimming through a flooded river in the Big Flood of 1955 and rescuing a great bridle mare he had shown and three other mares. It was quite a feat to save them and he had to head and tail them then ride the bridle mare through the flooded river to the bank. He then went back for a child's pony and together they struggled to the safety of the bank. Many animals were killed in that flood and the courage that Greg Lougher showed was recognized on National television in April, 1958.

Whilst running a successful training and breeding operation in the U.S. Greg met David Briggs and Bill Gunn. They went into partnership and brought 31 Quarter Horses to Australia. The trip to Australia involved a six month quarantine stay in England and at least two months at sea - or so Greg thought.

He loaded the horses onto a freight ship at the Stockton, California wharf in June, 1965. He then said goodbye to his friends, helpers, wife Carmel and two daughters (Gail and Lori). Alone, he looked after the horses for six weeks in their tie stalls. He fought seasickness, the oppressive heat going through the Panama Canal and the rough Atlantic seas. Keeping the water up to the horses was a full-time job and there was feeding and stalls to clean, as well as keeping the health of the horses in top order. The horses could not lie down and had to stand the whole trip. Due to an unscheduled stop at Le Havre, France, the horses were not permitted to unload in England as, at that time, there was an outbreak of Swamp Fever in southern France. Greg was told he had to destroy the horses or take them back to the U.S.

Belgium came to the rescue and Greg and his horses spent three months in quarantine there. He was asked to give demos at horse shows. The people had never seen Quarters Horses ridden, let alone reining or whatever Greg could demonstrate in the limited spaces. They loved what they saw and Greg took every opportunity to promote the breed. The interest did not waver when he finally arrived in England.

He was invited to exhibit them at some of the largest horse shows – he even took them fox-hunting. No one ever used stallions, and to be well behaved was even more unbelievable. Many of the top horsemen and women came to him during that six month stay in England. He worked with Pat Smythe, one of England's top showjumpers. He showed her his training methods and gear that helped her to reach the top of the tree that year.

Greg could not get all the horses on one ship out to Australia, so they landed in two shifts in September, 1967. All the horses were taken to Sam Hordern's property at Penrith where they spent another few months before they finally reached their home at Murrurundi, N.S.W. While Greg was in Penrith he was asked to give a cutting demonstration on Clover Cherry at the Warwick Gold Cup. He was then given special dispensation to enter the Gold Cup on Clover Lori (neither had competed in a campdraft before). Clover Lori had only been off the ship three weeks and had not had much work. Greg and Clover Lori were tied for first going into the final but he ended up fourth overall. This was a remarkable feat, and he even straightened his glasses and hat before he reached the first peg! The interest in Greg Lougher and his horses grew.

Greg gave demonstrations in cutting, reining and cowhorse in country shows in N.S.W. Then the big breakthrough came, not only for Greg but the Quarter Horse breed. The Sydney Royal Easter Show asked Greg and his two daughters to demonstrate his horses in the

main arena as a main attraction. Thousands of people filed past the four horses in 'A Block'.

Spectators would gather to watch the horses being exercised. Clover Cherry, Clover Lori, Clover Drift and Clarence Robinson paraded down the main street of Sydney to open the Show. Quarter Horses had been in Australia for quite some time by now, but never had they received such publicity. Greg was asked to return next year. He went to the Adelaide Royal as well.

Perhaps the reason Greg Lougher was so well admired was the fact he was a true horseman. He could ride any style of horse (he even rode the famous horse, Five Minutes to Midnight) and saw good in every breed. He gave schools at Ron Males stud to Arabian enthusiasts, at Gatton College he worked with Reg Williams, educated Sinclair Hill, the great polo player and his horses and Sinclair even credits Greg's helping him achieve his ten goal rating. He gave schools at Clover Leaf where Jim Haydon and Ian Johnson, Jim Page, Graham and Merv Lamey, Joy Peel, Brian and John Cobcroft, Terry O'Hanlon and many, many others came. Graham Amos, Donald Gunn and even Chilla Seeney, all at some stage were inspired by Greg Lougher.

Greg Lougher served as a member of the AQHA Board, was given a Life Membership and a special award from the Association for his contribution to the breed. Clover Cherry, Clover Lori and Clover Drift were also recognized with a special award – the Award of Honour.

Few people are ever held with such respect as Greg Lougher was, and still is in the horse world. His name is mentioned when Australian Stock Horse breeders get together remembering about starting their breed. Greg Lougher created so much interest in the Quarter Horse, something had to be done. In no way would Greg Lougher ever say he was solely responsible for the popularity of the Quarter Horse. The horse has a lot to do with that, as did many other hard working devoted breeders and members, but he sure did get the ball rolling!

Greg Lougher died in 1986 in California. He was cleaning a stall and had a heart attack. Some friends of his took his ashes to Battle Mountain in Nevada where he used to run wild horses and which he loved so dearly.

They scattered his ashes on that mountain. As they did, a band of wild horses bolted past in the valley. He will always remain with horses, his true passion, but let's hope in heaven they're all Quarter Horses.

With pride and respect, Gregory Paul Lougher was the first person inducted into the AQHA Hall of Fame. ♦

HORSE NUTRITION CAN BE SIMPLE©

Many of our medical conditions have diet and nutrition in their cause, prevention and management - and it's no different with horses. Common challenges that veterinarians and owners face (including stomach ulcers, colic, tying-up, laminitis, hoof conditions, leg and joint problems and performance issues) can be helped or even prevented with correct nutrition.

There are a few rules of thumb that can help us reduce many veterinary conditions and keep our horses stronger and healthier.

The simple rules when feeding

all horses are:

1. plenty of ad lib roughage/forage and then more
2. low starch/sugar concentrates and feeds
3. appropriate quality and quantity of protein
4. omega 3 fatty acids are important for all horses
5. vitamin E supports immune function
6. hooves and feet of many horses benefit from biotin
7. supplements can cause clinical and sub-clinical problems

1. ROUGHAGE AND GUT ULCERS: Stomach ulcers can affect any horse at any age and spending 6 hours with no roughage/forage increases stomach ulcer risk x 4. Chewing produces saliva which is very high in bicarb and helps neutralise the approximately 40 litres of stomach acid horses produce throughout the day.

Chewing produces saliva and to eat 1kg of hay:

- horses make 3000-3500 chewing movements and produce up to 45 litres of saliva a day.
- ponies make 5000-8000 chewing movements!
- Chewing 1kg of concentrate/hard feed only requires 800-1200 chews = less saliva and increased risk of stomach ulcers.

Medications can help ulcers heal, but recent studies have shown they can reduce absorption of calcium and other minerals.

The general rule if pasture is limited is a 50:50 mix of lucerne and grassy/meadow/oaten hay – available 24 hours a day. You should always include some lucerne, especially before work when reflux increases stomach acid levels. The high protein and calcium levels in lucerne buffer the acid and horses fed lucerne have a lower risk of ulcers. If not at pasture, horses / ponies need around 6kg a day for a 300kg pony, 8kg for a 400kg galloway and 10kg for a 500kg horse.

2. LOW STARCH, SUGAR AND NSC FEEDS:

High starch/sugar feeds also increase the risk of stomach ulcers and gut acidosis – and hence colic, hoof problems and laminitis. Many pelleted and extruded feeds are based on grain by-products such as millrun, bran and pollard which are all high in starch and sugar. It is particularly important to avoid these feeds for pregnant mares and youngsters. Gastric ulcers occur in 60% of crib-biting foals compared to 20% of non-crib-biting foals and the incidence is reduced in youngsters on high fibre/oil enriched diets.

At around 28 weeks gestation, pregnant mares have a reduced ability to take up glucose from the blood - this ensures it is diverted to the growing foal, but also increases risk for laminitis in pregnant mares and developmental orthopaedic diseases (DOD, OCD, bone cysts, bent legs) in foals. DOD became a widespread problem after high starch/sugar creep



feeds were introduced in the late 1960's. Ongoing studies into DOD have found genetics contributes approximately 25% and environment 75% - especially high starch/sugar feeds and rapid growth.

Most hock lesions are present at 1 month of age and there is evidence they can develop during gestation. Stifle lesions appear between 3 and 5 months of age and there is a positive correlation between OC and weight gain in the 3rd to 5th months. The risk continues through weanlings and until the yearling stage – making low starch/sugar diets important in


mares, foals and weanlings. Replacing such diets with high fibre/oil-enriched diets also affects temperament in weanlings and yearlings. Both before and for up to 10 months after weaning foals on a fibre-oil supplement show less stress.

Horses with recurrent exertional rhabdomyolysis and PSSM (type 1 or 2) limiting starch/sugar intake underpins management and current recommendations are that less than 20% of energy intake comes from sugar/starch and at least 20% from oil. All grains and high starch/sugar feeds - including feeds containing grain by-products such as millrun, bran, pollard, hominy meal should be avoided and used with caution.

Micronised and extruded feeds: Although micronized and extruded feeds benefit horses needing high energy grains, their increased small intestinal starch digestion can cause problems for other horses. Heat processing can increase small intestinal enzyme activities by over 446% profoundly increasing the damaging effects of starch and sugar-based feeds.

3. PROTEIN QUALITY AND ESSENTIAL AMINO ACIDS:

Are important for all horses regardless of discipline, work level or reproductive status, because they impact hoof strength and integrity, work capacity, body composition, power-to-weight ratio, endurance and reproduction. Muscle building is so specific that if the feed meets required levels of 9 essential amino acids, but has only half the tenth, body protein synthesis (ie muscle, bone, red cells etc) may be reduced by up to 50%. A deficiency of any single essential amino acid places a limit on tissue building. Just as the shortest plank in a barrel limits the amount of water the barrel contains, an essential amino acid deficiency places a limit on new cell creation.



Once an essential amino acid runs out, the building of tissues that require that amino acid, stops and unusable amino acids are converted to fat. Lucerne, soy meal and whey protein are all 'good quality' because they are high in lysine, methionine, threonine, leucine-amino acids that build muscle, stamina, tendon strength, bone, red cells etc.

4. OILS ESPECIALLY THOSE HIGH IN OMEGA 3: are also important for all horses. Adding oil to the diet provides benefits for all horses in terms of acidosis, arthritis, behaviour, coat, fertility, inflammation, immunity, PSSM, vaccination response, skin, temperament and tying up. And, oils also offer owners another tool to maintain body condition in horses that lose appetite when under the stress of training, competition and travelling. Oil provides around 3 times as much energy as grains – so 330ml of oil provides the same amount of energy as 1kg of oats – but without the risk of ‘hot’ behaviour and hind-gut acidosis.

5. VITAMIN E: a powerful anti-oxidant and supports optimum performance and immune function - including improved colostral IgG for new foals and in older horses, response to vaccination. Most diets do not reach minimum recommended daily intakes. Jenquine all-4-feet® is high in vitamin E.

6. BIOTIN: Although the healthy horse gut synthesizes most B-vitamins - including biotin - stress, travelling, competition and stabling can reduce production and increase requirements. Hooves and feet of many horses benefit from biotin with additional zinc and methionine that together promote hoof wall growth and integrity.

7. SUPPLEMENTS can cause clinical and sub-clinical problems (these can't be seen but do impact on health and performance): 60-77 % of horse owners in Australia concentrate/manufactured feeds plus up to five (and sometimes 10!) additional supplements.

Risk of overlap and subclinical toxicity is high and many horses are being fed in excess of dietary requirements - with some excesses approaching maximum tolerable levels.

Leanne and Madison Caban,
hailing from Emerald, QLD,
have both had significant
successes at the Cap Coast
ABHA Finals this year.***



With Leanne taking out the runner up 2020 ABHA Championships Open Division – 4th Division on ‘Mornin Mohawk Q-82903.’ Madison took home 2 trophy saddles for her wins in the 2020 ABHA Championships Junior Division - 1st Division riding ‘Peptos Jackson Roc Q-67111’, during which she averaged 15.826 seconds per run, as well as the 2020 ABHA Championships Open Division - 1st Division riding ‘Smart Like Cooper Q-70475’, also held over 2 rounds. Madison’s average to take the win was 16.478 sec. Madison also placed 5th overall on ‘Bid For Lil Acre Q-95888’ in the 2020 ABHA QLD Championships Classic, which is for horses six years old or under. Madison had stellar results in each round, running a 17.541 in Round 1, while she ran a 17.062 in Round 2, bringing her average to 17.3015 sec.

Leanne attributes her love for horses to her parents, and says *“I will be forever grateful that they encouraged my passion for horses.”* Growing up, Leanne’s mum always loved horses but never had one of her own. When she met Leanne’s Dad, he had a team of stock horses for work, so she had the opportunity to learn to ride. *“When they married, they went into the trucking business, and Dad dabbled in a few racehorses, and I rode trackwork for him. Mum and Dad gave me the best opportunities that they could afford for me to ride in Pony Club, Showjumping, and Campdrafting etc.,”* Leanne recalls.

Leanne always enjoyed the sporting events in Pony Club and giving the horses their gallops when she rode trackwork. *“When I got into the sport of Rodeo after completing school, I was still living in Julia Creek, North Qld, and there wasn’t a huge number of events. But when the Northern Run of Pro Rodeo’s came around, I just started with them. I remember seeing all the travelling Cowgirls for the first time and made it a goal to mix it with them one day. It was not only the speed of Barrel Racing that I fell in love with, but everything Rodeo was about,”* said Leanne.

Leanne’s hard work and dedication have seen her bring home many titles over the years, including:

- 1995 APRA/WPRA All Round Champion.
- 3 x CRCA All Round Champion.
- Many circuit titles and NFR qualifications both with APRA and ABCRA.
- 3 x ATRA National Barrel Racing Champion.

“In 2014, I was invited by Mr Yu of Bau Huo, Qingdao, China, to spend a month at his equine complex to train riders and horses in Barrel Racing. In 2015, I was a guest presenter at the QSEC Horse and Home Show to share my knowledge in the sport. My all-time highlight, however, is breaking the Australian Barrel Racing record in 1993 at Mt Isa Rodeo and holding that record for six years.” With a resume like this, it’s no wonder Leanne is a Clinician and Horse trainer.

Leanne's main barrel racing mount is 11yo Chestnut gelding 'Morns Akka Dakka Roc' Q-69772, a 'Flashy Pepto' Q-53998 x 'Traditional Elly' Q-51402.

Not limited to one, Leanne has two other horses she competes on: 14yo Palomino gelding 'Peppys Royal Rogue' Q-64342 by 'Flashy Pepto' Q-53998 x 'Royal Traditions' Q-26426 and the 4th division Open Winner 5yo Bay gelding 'Mornin Mohawk' Q- 82903 by IMP 'SLR Mojos Workin' Q-67448 x 'Maggie Morn' Q-54922.

Canadian Barrel Racing Clinician Judy Myllymaki had some advice that has stuck with Leanne over the years, and that was 'never listen to the crows on the fence.' "I apply this to life, as well. I stay in my lane and run my own race, and that really helps me stay focused on the task at hand and doing the best I can for my family, myself and my horse. There are so many great barrel racers both here and overseas that I admire, along with horsemen and horsewomen in many other disciplines. Basically, I admire the competitors that put horsemanship first and are really there for the horse and bringing out their best."

Leanne advises fellow competitors to "Just do you! Set goals, stay focused and chip away at them to achieve your dreams."

"There are so many great Barrel Racing competitors. Early in my career Bridget Brandenburg was a big influence, and hers was one of the first clinics I ever attended. She is someone I look up to as a friend and mentor and is always there if I need her. She is still one of the best jockeys around to help bring out the best in any horse. I also always admired the Schiller girls for their talent and horsemanship when I first got into the sport, and their longevity is a testament to the greats that they still are. Along the way, I have seen the likes of Adele Edwards continuously train and ride some of the best horses this country has seen, and my sister-in-law Wendy Caban has made a huge impact on our sport as well. I could go on and on with more Australian Champions I have enjoyed watching and competing against, but then there would be a list a mile long of American superstars but I would be showing my age if I rattled off too many," Leanne says with a smile.

"Besides a lot of hard work, I would have to credit my husband Dale with being the driving force behind my success. He works tirelessly at a full-time mining job to, in his words, 'keep me in the lifestyle I am accustomed to!'. He does all our shoeing and trimming, which is a task in itself with 15 odd horses to attend to, and he always ensures we have an adequate supply of quality hay. He certainly plays a vital part in enabling me to focus on developing myself as a competitor and a clinician."

Leanne would like to acknowledge and thank her long-time sponsors for their constant support and guidance. They include Prydes EasiFeed, Equissage Australia, Double J Saddlery and Coolhorse.

“I really don’t want to retire until I have claimed an APRA Australian Barrel Racing Title. I feel like Lisa Lockhart as she has achieved so much in American Barrel Racing but is yet to win a World Title in the PRCA/WPRA. Like I said earlier, I will just keep chipping away at it,” says Leanne of her future goals.

‘Don’t knock your fellow competitors. By boosting others, you will boost yourself. A little competition is a good thing, and severe competition is a blessing.’ Maddie’s love of horses comes naturally, having grown up with them since the beginning.

With all the family competing in Rodeos, and her Mum a Champion Barrel Racer, Maddie has been competing in Barrel Races since she could sit up on a horse and has been riding on her own since age 2. *“I was 4 when my parents entered me at all the Rodeos of my first APRA Northern Run. It was the first thing*

I could do independently so I just loved being able to get out in front of the crowd and go as fast as I could,” Maddie recalls.

This year events have been limited due to the Corona Virus Pandemic, but the duo would generally attend around 30-40 events per year. The Year 12 Student has had many career highlights over the years, including:

- 5 times qualifier in Barrel Racing to the APRA Junior NFR.
- Runner Up APRA Jnr Barrel Racing Title in 2019.
- Multiple ATRA and CHBHA Jnr Barrel Racing Champion.
- Winning the Open Divisional Barrel Race on Smart Like Cooper (Q- 70475) at the recent Qld Championships in Gracemere which was a career highlight in taking that out against over 300 horses.
- Winning the Junior Divisional on 12yo Chestnut Gelding ‘Peptos Jackson Roc’ at the same event - ‘Flashy Pepto’ (Q-53998) x (Q-28560) ‘Miss Traditional T.’
- Finishing fifth in the Classic event with a young horse I started on barrels. 7yo Chestnut Mare ‘Bid For Lil Acre’ (Q-95888) by ‘Little Biddy Acre’ (Q-59344) X ‘Savvy Lil Hank’ (Q-47651)

"Coming into this event I really wasn't expecting much at all. I had only competed at some local jackpots on Jackson and even though Hammer 'aka Smart Like Cooper Q-70475' was fit due to being roped on I had not got to run him all year. I also had to retire my great old horse 'Decker' so it was tough. My confidence going into the weekend was low as I couldn't practice due to rain and I had been ill. After my 1st exhibition run on Hammer I was still worried as he was all over the place. I gave him another exhibition run then we pulled it together. There is no better feeling winning on horses you have trained yourself. Dad had trained Hammer into an awesome rope horse but I patterned him on the barrels. I also trained Biddy (Bid for a Lil Acre Q-95888) who I placed 5th in the Futurity on."

"Dad purchased Hammer from Jason Leitch about 5 years ago. He had been trained in cutting but didn't make the grade so was being used as a turn back horse. He is very quirky and doesn't like too much affection. After taking out the Junior 1D saddle on Jackson, who my mum trained, I was blown away to win the open 1D. It was certainly the cherry on top."

No way in the world did I think I had a chance against more than 300 riders, to come out on top. I'm thankful for everyone that helped me get to where I am including my parents and sponsors, because nothing would be possible without them. There were so many great

competitors and I really didn't think I had a high chance of even placing."

"The best advice I have received is just to go out and have fun and what will be will be. I look up to my mum as she is the one that got me started and is always in my corner. Don't put too much pressure on yourself. Have fun with it!"

"I love watching Lisa Lockhart and Hailey Kinsel, and in 2019 I got to watch them both live at the PRCA World Finals in Las Vegas. I also got to see Lisa compete at the Elite Finals in Dallas, Texas, in 2016. I got to go down into the arena, meet with her and get her autograph."

Maddie believes having a positive mindset, a lot of hard work and always staying humble are the keys to her success. "Oh, and of course, Mum and Dad and the opportunity they have given me to work with and ride some great horses."

Maddie would like to acknowledge and thank her great sponsors at "Rydeweld in Townsville, who have really looked after me over the years, and Coolhorse helps me out with equipment and ropes. I want to thank the organisers of the Qld Championships and all the great sponsors."

Future goals for this young competitor are to win a junior APRA title in Barrel racing, then work towards an Open Title. Maddie would also like to compete in America one day at a high level. "I'm not in competition with anybody but myself". "It's about competition and having fun with friends." ♦






