



OOCYTE PERMIT APPLICATION

An Oocyte is an unfertilised egg that can be frozen or retained from a Donor mare. It can be preserved in frozen storage or held in a Donor mare as a breeding right. This form is not for embryos

Section One: If a mare owner sells their mare and retains Oocytes from that mare, **prior to the sale of the mare**, the mare owner must apply for an Oocyte Permit.

One (1) form must be completed for every Oocyte. This form must be returned to the AQHA for processing.
