Bred by Audrey and Florence Smith of San Clemente, California. Shown lightly in the USA for some circuit champion awards, a ROM Western Pleasure and some Hunter under Saddle points, it was decided by Winderadeen Corporation not to show him in Australia, but for his foals to display his talents.

He was bought specifically to breed pleasure horses over the large group of mares that Winderadeen had campaigned in the all-round side of the Quarter Horse industry in Australia. This included the Youth and Amateur classes as well as Western Pleasure Trail, Hunter under Saddle and Western Riding.



From his first foal drop of six foals, he produced:-

PUB CRAWL Q-37392 (out of RED SALLY JO Q-14654) who won the 2year old Pleasure at the Quarter Horse Championships in 2000.

WINDERADEEN GAY CEE BARS Q-35897 (out of GAR BAR MINNIE Q-12511). Superior Western Pleasure horse and the top 2year old Pleasure Horse in the Nation in 1999. In 1999, 2000 and 2001 she was the Champion in her relevant Western Pleasure classes, being a dominant competitor at major competition. But, as a broodmare, she has proven an even more powerful force. Her progeny include:-

ANNLEE WAIT N CEE Q-46423 (out of POCOMELIA Q-6096). An outstanding mare who has attained 1337 AQHA points in 33 awards in Open, Amateur and Youth events. This mare is still competing at a high level and just getting better.

WINDERADEEN GAY CEE GOLD Q-43410 (out of GAY BAR MINNIE Q-12511). Foaled in 1999, this mare went on to be the NPHA 2year old Western Pleasure Futurity Champion in 2002 and then went on to produce the NPHA 2year old Western Pleasure Futurity Champion of 2008. A Superior Western Pleasure horse with 527.5 AQHA points, as well as being an AQHA Open and Amateur Champion, this mare has been an outstanding representative of CEE A BARPASSER.

WINDERADEEN PASSIN BLUE Q-46102 (out of ISABLUQ Q-15100). Without doubt, one of the most successful performance horses during his show career. This gelding amassed over 1900 points and 39 AQHA awards – an outstanding achievement.

YULGILBAR RUN N CEE Q-50344 (out of CAGIE BOOM Q-10372). This gelding has amassed 1563 AQHA points and 37 AQHA awards.

Other great performers are YLS CEE ME CRUIZ Q-43288 (out of RISKAY BOOM Q-15108) with 1114 points; WINDERADEEN GAY BAR MICKY Q-45347 (out of GAY BAR MINNIE Q-12511); WINDERADEEN A SHADY PAST Q-58246 (out of WINDERADEEN SHADY LADY Q-24632); WINDERADEEN SHADOWS Q-46321 (out of WINDERADEEN SHADY LADY Q-24632) and the list goes on.

Of CEE A BARPASSER's progeny, 122 have been AQHA point earners. They have amassed 21,304.5 AQHA points and 1,164 AQHA awards.

CEE A BARPASSER has undoubtedly lead the way for the "new" generation of arena performance horses in this country, and left a band of broodmares second to none for subsequent new stallions to prove their worth. In 2011, he was the Leading Sire of Performance horses for the AQHA, an amazing feat as he has been deceased since 2007.
