



AQHA Limited Judges Permit

An AQHA Limited Judges Permit is designed as an entry level into our AQHA Judges System. This allows new applicant Judges to gain valuable experience at 'A' Approved AQHA Affiliate shows, within the limitations of the following classes: Halter, Showmanship, Hunter in Hand, Hunter Under Saddle & Western Pleasure.

To gain an AQHA Limited Judges Permit you must attend an on-line information session, then complete and pass the AQHA written and video Judging Testing.

COMPONENTS

INFORMATION SESSION: These unique on-line information sessions will be held with an Accredited member of the AQHA Judges Sub-Committee. Includes discussion on AQHA Showmanship Judging and its systems and information on what to expect in the written and video testing.

WRITTEN TEST: The applicant will be required to complete an On-line Theory Test covering areas such as Judges responsibilities, equipment, attire and specific class rules. This test will be in the format of multiple choice, true/false and short answer.

VIDEO TEST: The applicant will be required to judge videos of the classes and submit their placings on-line. Scoresheets are submitted to the AQHA office upon completion of the video testing component.

Components	PROPOSED PROFICIENCY
Information Session	The applicant must attend this session before sitting for the written and video tests.
Written Test	The applicant must be able to obtain a minimum overall score of 70%
Video Test	The applicant must be able to: A. Correctly identify, a minimum of 70% of the 1 st and last placed horses in each event. B. Correctly identify the order of the placegetters; at least 65% of the time. C. Correctly identify all major penalties in the scored events; at least 70% of the time

If an applicant does not pass the written or video testing components, they will not achieve their AQHA Limited Judges Permit but will be advised which areas they are required to study and encouraged to re-sit.
