OTHER AWARDS:

Note: The successful applicant will not be permitted to hold any other major scholarship.

Auscott should be notified immediately of applicants acceptance of any other major scholarship.

PAYMENTS:

Payments will be made from a trust account in equal instalments during each tertiary year of the scholarship; the amount of each being that agreed upon with the Administrator.

It is intended that these payments will be largely governed by each student's needs and can be modified to suit.

REQUIREMENTS:

Recipients will be required to provide copies of each semesters results, at the end of each semester. In addition to a brief report outlining his/her progress during that year.

Occasionally students may be asked to speak to local schools in their district.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Auscott Scholarships were first awarded in 1969 for students from the Narrabri and Dubbo area High schools. In the following year a Postgraduate Scholarship in agriculture was awarded and the Auscott Scholarship Program was succesfully launched. A third scholarship was instituted in 1980 for the Moree area and with our expansion into the Murrumbidgee in 2014, we are pleased to offer a fourth scholarship for the Hay area.

Final year high school students, residing within the geographical limits as laid down in the Conditions of Award (areas explained below), are each year invited to apply for an award under the program. The scholarships are tenable at both university and non-university higher education institutions (e.g. TAFE) acceptable to the Scholarship Committee.

An Auscott Education Scholarship will be awarded annually to one student from a High School in each of the following valleys:

- Namoi Valley: Narrabri & Wee Waa High School.
- Macquarie Valley: student being resident either in the shire of Warren or the Municipality of Narromine and attending secondary school in Narromine, Trangie or Warren.
- Gwydir Valley: Moree Secondary College students & students completing their secondary schooling at a location within the Moree Plains Shire.
- Murrumbidgee Valley: Hay War Memorial High School students completing their secondary schooling at a location within the Hay Shire.

WHAT DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP INCLUDE?

The aim of this scholarship is to cover the costs of books, accommodation and contribute towards basic living expenses up to an annual amount of \$11,500.

Please note the scholarship does not cover HELP fees.

CAN I APPLY?

Applicants will be required to:

- have completed a full six-year secondary school course
- have gained admission to a tertiary educational institution
- have displayed community and civic responsibility
- preferably have participated in extracurricular activities
- completed the prescribed application form and lodged it with the Secretary of the Auscott Education Scholarship Committee, c/ - Auscott Office in your area on or before:

OTHER CONDITIONS & REQUIREMENTS

SELECTION

Selection will be made by the Auscott Education Scholarship Committee. The committee normally consists of representatives from Auscott and the NSW Department of Education. The decision of the Selection Committee is final.

The succesful applicant will be required to produce documentary evidence showing their acceptance by a tertiary educational institution. Scholarships are available for those students commencing tertiary study in 2020 and are not available to be carried over due to a gap year.

CRITERIA

Criteria used by the Committee for awarding a scholarship include realistic ambition, need, the ability to succeed in a chosen course, motivation, academic performance, personal presentation, community involvement and maturity. Academic results are not the sole basis on which a decision is reached.

DURATION

A scholarship normally runs for three or four years, depending on the course chosen, and is currently capped at \$11,500 p/a. In special circumstances Auscott will consider extension beyond these limits. Scholarships may be deferred for one year due to illness or exceptional circumstances - subject to approval by Auscott. Should a scholar fail in any year, benefits will cease. If the year is repeated successfully, at the student's own expense, payment of benefits will be resumed. Should failure be repeated, the tenure of scholarship will cease unless the failure is attributable to circumstances beyond the scholar's control, in which case Auscott may direct that benefits be continued
