Marketing and Tourism:

Airport Reporting and Safety:

Construction Engineer:

Providing specialist advice in the design and construction of large scale construction works, including the Centre of Sporting Excellence.

Road Infrastructure Operator:

Undertake a variety of operational works as part of a team in the maintenance and construction of civil infrastructure, using machinery such as a backhoe, front end loader, bobcat, excavator, truck and roller.

Sport and Recreation Development Officer:

Providing strategic planning and development for sports and recreation facilities.

Horticulture and Arboriculture Specialist:

Providing specialist technical advice, coordination and monitoring of horticulture and arboriculture services, to our vast array of parks, gardens and streetscapes.

IT, Accounting and Human Resources

IT Officer:

Providing system and network support, technical guidance, training in networks, web services and corporate applications.

Accounting:

Facilitate financial processes and budget analysis.

Human Resources:

Providing professional support and advice to Tamworth Regional Council's staff including Industrial Relations, Recruitment, Training and Injury and Risk Management.

Water and Waste

Fitter Machinist:

Perform fabrication, manufacture, repair, installation, maintenance, calibration and operation of complex mechanical systems.

Laboratory Technician:

Performing sampling, testing and analysis of water, wastewater and soil and calibrating a wide range of field and laboratory equipment.

Sustainability Coordinator:

Creating and implementing strategies to improve the community's understanding of sustainability and promote conservation, waste reduction, increased recycling and other initiatives.

Environmental Officer:

Working with the EPA at our waste management sites to ensure we are achieving the best possible outcomes for our ongoing environmental health.

Planning and Compliance

Development Assessment:

Providing town planning services to the community and building industry.

Building Inspector:

Undertake assessments on a wide range of construction and building works to ensure compliance with the relevant regulations.

Environmental Health Officer:

Investigate, report on and take appropriate action regarding a range of Environmental, Health, Development and Compliance matters such as food safety inspections, noise assessments and onsite sewage management inspections.

Crime Prevention and Development Compliance Ranger:

Supporting the coordination and delivery of Council's Crime Prevention Plan, including graffiti management, liquor licensing, investigating and reporting on incidents.
