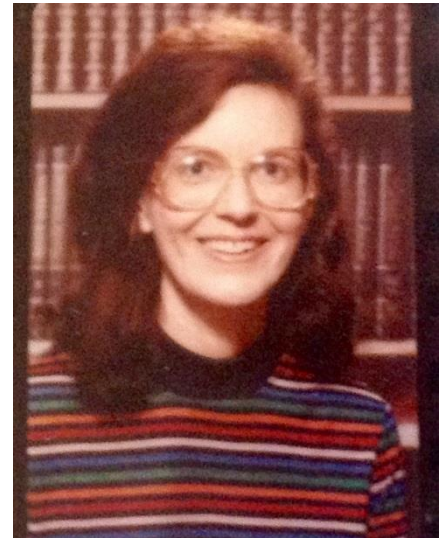


THE RUTH MUNRO SCHOLARSHIP

*Ruth Munro was a much-loved teacher of English, Ancient History and Latin, who captivated and inspired her students over her distinguished teaching career of 40 years at Calrossy Anglican School. She was the teacher that many alumna of the school remember, impacting on generations of past students. She is remembered in the school as a most outstanding teacher who inspired many to pursue further study and make the most of their education. Posthumously Calrossy has published a collection of poetry in her name, *The Book(let) of Ruth*. The Ruth Munro Scholarship is supported by Past Staff and Alumni of Calrossy who have financially committed to assisting a student's journey at Calrossy.*



This scholarship is only awarded to an applicant seeking entry into Year 7 at Calrossy Anglican School. It will last for the six years of the successful applicant's Secondary schooling. An interview of students and parents may be part of the criteria for selection for this scholarship.

The successful applicant would need to demonstrate the potential to make a significant positive contribution to the academic and cultural life of the school across a range of activities that may include outstanding achievement in areas such in public speaking, debating, drama, music and STEAM.

The award will be made as part remission of tuition and/or boarding fees, subject only to satisfactory attitude and application. It would be expected that while holding the scholarship the student would actively participate in the areas of school life that were the basis for the awarding of this scholarship.
