### eCalrossy (Siblings or other discounts are not applicable)

Per term cost includes Macbook \$1,525 per Term or \$6,100 per year.

### Prep (Sibling or other discounts are not applicable)

3 Days - \$1,570 per term or \$6,280 per year

4 Days - \$2,090 per term or \$8,360 per year

5 Days - \$2,615 per term or \$10,460 per year

### APPLICATION FOR ENROLMENT

A \$110 non-refundable application fee per student is charged upon lodging an enrolment application. A \$1,000 Enrolment Bond is charged per family and credited to the final school fee account upon the last student completing their Calrossy education.

### STUDENT ENROLMENT, WITHDRAWAL & NOTICE OF INTENT TO LEAVE

By accepting an offer of enrolment you are agreeing to pay school fees by the due date each term.

One term's notice is required in writing (by email) addressed to the Principal for any student leaving Calrossy. If sufficient notice has not been provided, the enrolling parties will be charged a term's fee for each student.

### SCHOOL FEES ARE DUE ON THE FIRST DAY OF EACH TERM

Any account with a debit balance at the end of week 4 of each term will incur a late fee of 4% (or 16% p.a.). Families paying the full year's fees prior to 20th February 2023 are entitled to a 2.5% discount.

### Sibling Discounts

(Applicable to siblings of the same family in attendance at the same time, excluding prep and E-Calrossy) Second Child 30% Sibling Discount applied to tuition portion of fees only. Third & Subsequent Children 50% Sibling Discount applied to tuition portion of fees only. All discount combinations are capped at a maximum of 50% of the tuition fees per student.

### Casual Boarding (Secondary)

**Subject to availability** - Bookings via boarding office [boardinghouse@calrossy.nsw.edu.au](mailto:boardinghouse@calrossy.nsw.edu.au) or 5776 5161.

Casual boarding charge of \$140 per night for day students and weekly boarders (includes meals).

### Weekly Boarding Discount

Eligible to boarders staying Monday - Thursday throughout the term. Casual boarding charges of \$140 per night are applied for additional nights accommodation. Years 7-11, weekly boarding discount is \$350 per term. Year 12's \$465 per term. If a weekly boarder stays more than 3 casual nights per term, full term's cost will be applied. Discounts and/or additional charges are applied to the following term's invoice.

### TUITION FEES

Are applicable for all delivery methods which may include face to face and non-face to face learning as deemed necessary.

## CO-CURRICULAR FEES

Includes cost of most curriculum based and year group excursions and expeditions as well as printing costs, compulsory instrument hire for music program, student accident insurance (excluding ambulance trips), wellbeing programs and junior school classroom resources. Given our inclusive fee structure, these charges are payable whether or not students participate in class activities or utilise the services. Co-curricular fees do not include representative sport, livestock or equine registration costs; permanent or casual school lunches as these are an additional cost to students choosing to participate.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

The HUB/Portal – You are able to pay fees online. Log on to The HUB and use the same login details to access the portal. From there you can view your school fee account, transaction histories and make payments.

BPay and Direct Debit are useful options for families who prefer to make regular payments towards fees. Please contact the finance office to make direct debit arrangements and to calculate what your weekly/fortnightly amount should be. All accounts are to reach a nil balance by end of Term 4 each year.

Credit Card/Debit Card/EFTPOS facilities are available and we are able to process most payments over the phone or in person. No surcharge is applied on this payment method.

Edstart is an organisation specialising in lending for education purposes allowing families to pay off their fees up to 5 years after their youngest child finishes at Calrossy. If an application is approved, they will pay Calrossy the amount of the invoice in full, while you make payments to them via agreed instalment. ## SPLIT BILLING OPTIONS

If you require split billing, we are able to invoice each parent (or other nominated party) a specific portion of their child's education costs. If this is applicable for your family; please contact the Finance Office for a confidential appointment.

## ACCOUNT ARREARS & DEBT RECOVERY

Any family with an account balance greater than one term's fee, risk their children's placement within the school being revoked and the debt will be forwarded to a collection agency for management. Any costs associated with the collection of the debt will be added to their existing school fee account.

Students may be eligible for re-enrolment at Calrossy Anglican School pending approval from the Chief Operating Officer once the debt is cleared and a successful payment arrangement has been established.

## ADDITIONAL COSTS

Costs associated with casual boarding, extra-curricular sporting activities, health centre costs, collection costs incurred with unpaid fees, late fees, direct debit dishonour charges, Apple care repair excess, non returned/damaged texts, library resources, equipment or wilful damage to school property may be added to your school fees account.

## BURSARY ASSISTANCE

The Calrossy Anglican School Foundation assists families with annual bursaries. Limited assistance is available to help families in genuine and temporary financial need. If you are experiencing financial hardship please download a bursary application form from the Calrossy website, complete it and return it to the Finance Office. Be sure to include all supporting documents so it can be properly assessed. Any family who receives bursary assistance will forfeit their enrolment bond. Submission of an application does not guarantee that assistance will be provided.
