*This newly established Scholarship, first to be awarded in 2019 (the Centenary year of the school) for 2020, honours one of Calrossy's most outstanding and passionate alumna, Mary England (Melville '43). Mary was a significant figure in our alumni history and promoted the school and its networks enthusiastically. She worked tirelessly to keep the school graduates active and connected as much as possible. Mary hosted fetes and convened alumni get-togethers in her own home in Sydney, providing an extraordinary welcome to ex-students young and old. Her contribution spanned many generations. She was extremely willing to share her fond memories of her time at Tamworth Church of England Girl's School and supported the school 100% of the time. The Drawing Room in Calrossy House has been named in her honour, in recognition of her significant contribution to the community of Calrossy.*



This scholarship is only awarded to an applicant who is the child of an ex-student of Calrossy Anglican School or William Cowper Anglican School and is entering into Year 7. It will last for the six years of the successful applicant's Secondary schooling.

The successful applicant would need to demonstrate the potential to make a significant positive contribution to the life of the school across a range of activities that may include academic studies, music, sport, agriculture, Christian involvement, public speaking and debating.

The award will be made as part remission of tuition and/or boarding fees, subject only to satisfactory attitude and application. It would be expected that while holding the scholarship the student would actively participate in the areas of school life that were the basis for the awarding of this scholarship.
