### Ruth Munro Scholarship



Awarded to applicants who demonstrate the potential to make a significant positive contribution across a range of activities that may include outstanding achievement in areas such as public speaking, debating, drama, music and STEAM.

- The student must be entering into Year 7
- The application is subject only to a satisfactory attitude and application
- The student would be expected to actively participate in the areas that were the basis for the awarding of this scholarship
- The award will be made as part remission of tuition and/or boarding fees
- The scholarship will last for the six years of the successful applicant's Secondary schooling

### Mary England Scholarship



Awarded to an applicant who is the child of an ex-student of Calrossy Anglican School or William Cowper Anglican School, who demonstrates the potential to make a significant positive contribution to the life of the school across a range of activities that may include academic studies, music, sport, agriculture, Christian involvement, public speaking and debating.

- The student must be the child of an ex-student and entering into year 7
- The application is subject only to a satisfactory attitude and application
- The student would be expected to actively participate in the areas that were the basis for the awarding of this scholarship
- The award will be made as part remission of tuition and/or boarding fees
- The scholarship will last for the six years of the successful applicant's Secondary schooling
